

## CAR LOADINGS

No. 41

(Forty-first Week ended October 13th, 1934.)

Car loadings for the week ended October 13th were affected by the holiday on October 8th and decreased from 51,560 cars for the previous week to 53,050 cars, but the index number rose from 68,98 to 74.25. Also, the total was 1,257 cars greater than the total of 50,303 cars for the corresponding week in 1933. Compared with 1933 grain increased by 377 cars, livestock by 399 cars, lumber by 170 cars, other forest products by 351 cars, ore by 392 cars, merchandise by 414 cars and miscellaneous freight by 1,598 cars. Coal decreased by 2,029 cars with the remaining commodities showing only slight decreases.


In the eastern division the loadings amounted to 27,776 cars, a decrease of 1,552 cars from 1933, and the index number decreased from 71.44 to 67.66. In the western division loadings increased by 724 cars over last week and 2,809 cars over 1933 and the index number rose from 74.09 in 1933 to 84.01. Grain loadings were 1,599 cars heavier than the previous week and 482 cars heavier than for 1933. Compared with 1933, livestock, other forest products, ore and miscellaneous freight showed substantial increases with coal decreasing by 375 cars, pulpwood by 37 cars and pulp and paper by 25 cars.


