## CAR LOADINGS

No. 46

(Forty-sixth Week ended November 17th, 1934)


Car loadings for the week ended November 17th amounted to 50,264 cars as against 51,228 cars for the previous week and 47,420 cars a year ago. The largest gain over last year's loadings was in miscellaneous freight which increased from 9,342 cars to 11,779 cars and, although slightly lower than for the previous week, the index number rose from 72.22 to 77.05. Grain was 605 cars over last year's loadings, but was light compared with previous years'. Coal declined by 490 cars and coke by 536 cars. Pulp and paper was above last year's by 304 cars and ore by 386 cars.


Total loadings in the eastern division at 30,644 cars, were 149 cars above the previous week's and the index number rose from 68.92 to 71.34.

In the western division light loading of grain and coal was the chief factor in reducing the total from 20,733 cars for the previous week to 19,620 cars. Although miscellaneous freight declined 180 cars, this was less than the normal seasonal decline and the index number rose from 109.94 to 116.67.
