CAR LOADINGS

Ninth Week ended March 3rd, 1934


Car loadings for the week ended March 3rd amounted to 42,610 cars, a gain of 1,147 cars over the previous week and of 8,399 cars over the corresponding week last year. The index number, however, declined from 72.39 for the previous week to 71.56. Miscellaneous freight was heavier in both divisions, the total being 2,565 over last year's. Coal followed with an increase of 2,250 cars, merchandise was up by 1,227 cars, lumber by 733 cars, pulpwood by 723 cars, pulp and paper by 701 cars and other forest products by 743 cars.

Although grain loading in the western division was 1,544 cars lighter than in 1933 and coke and ore declined slightly, all other commodities increased and the total of 13,735 cars was 948 cars greater than for the corresponding week last year.

In the eastern division all commodities registered improvement over last year, the total of 28,875 cars being greater by 7,451 cars, or 35 per cent.
