CAR LOADINGS

Na. 28

(Twenty-eighth Week ended July 11th, 1936.)

Car loadings for the week ended July 11th amounted to 47,912 cars as against 45,668 cars in 1935. Grain declined by 753 cars, the western division being down by 1,608 cars and the eastern division up by 855 cars, and coal was lighter by 81 cars, but all other commodities showed increases. Miscellaneous was heavier by 913 cars, merchandise by 537 cars, ore by 513 cars, other forest products by 302 cars, pulp and paper by 299 cars, pulpwood by 56 cars, lumber by 106 cars, coke by 10 cars and live stock by 342 cars.


The large decrease in grain in the western division reduced the total from 15,842 cars in 1935 to 15,503 cars. With only small decreases in coal, coke and other forest products and increases in all other commodities in the eastern division, total loadings increased from 29,826 cars in 1935 to 32,409 cars.


