Car loadings for the week onded June 11 th dropped to 41,466 cars from 43,145 cars for the previous week and 47.917 cars for the corresponding week last year. In computing the index number no adjustment has been made for the holiday on June 9 th, this being only the second year containing the holiday. Foe index member dropped to new low for 1936,1937 , and 1938 at 66.33 .

Only two groups showed increases over last year: grain was up by 82 cars and ore by 521 cars. Miscellaneous decreased by 1,942 cars, or 14 per cent, coal by 1,239 cars, or 23 per cont, merchandise by 2,103 cars, or 8 per cont, palp and paper by 975 cars, or 38 per cent, lumber by 776 cars. or 29 per cent, pulpwood by 474 cars, live stock by 339 cars, other forest product: by 123 cars, and coice by 83 cars.
