CAR LOADINGS

(Twenty-third Week ended June 10, 1939)

Car loadings for the week ended June 10, 1939 dropped to 42,497 cars from 43,935 cars for the previous week and the index number dropped from 69.71 to 67.98. This is the fifth consecutive week to show a decrease in the index number. Compared with loadings last year, the total was up by 1,008 cars. Grain increased by 1,057 cars; coal by 583 cars; lumber by 357 cars; pulp and paper by 130 cars and other forest products to 223 cars. Live stock was lighter by 31 cars; coke by 29 cars; pulpwood by 361 cars; ore by 381 cars; merchandise by 40 cars and miscellaneous by 500 cars. Total loadings in the western division were heavier than in 1938 by 1,412 cars grain being heavier by 1,112 cars, but in the eastern division coal was the only commodity showing a large increase (542 cars) and the total dropped from 29,344 cars in 1938 to 28,940 cars.




