## CAR LOADINGS

7ol. XVI.

(Thirty-eighth Week Ended September 23, 1939)

Car loadings for the week ended September 23rd increased to 72,157 cers from 71,274 cars for the previous week and 60,664 cars for the corresponding week last year. This was the heaviest loading since 1930.

The index number adjusted for seasonal variations declined from 99.03 for the previous week to 95.80.


Heavy loading of grain in the western division and of miscellaneous freight in the eastern division were the main factors in the increase over last year's loadings. These two items were up by 3,053 cars and 2,004 cars respectively. Total grain loadings were heavier than in 1938 by 3,866 cars, live stock was up by 198 cars, coal by 1,740 cars, coke by 410 cars, lumber by 969 cars, pulp and peper by 717 cars, other forest products by 119 cars, ore by 408 cars, merchandise by 847 cars and miscellaneous by 2,492 cars. The only decrease was 273 cars of pulpwood.


Total loadings for the eastern division increased from 31,024 cars in 1938 to 37,871 cars and for the western division from 29,640 cars to 34,286 cars.
