Car loadings for the week ended September 30 dropped to 68,882 cars from 72,157 cars for the previous week. Congestion at western elevators was a factor in reducing grain loading in the western division from 21,802 cars to 17,578 cars which also was 142 cars below last year's loadings. Total loadings of grain in both divisions were lighter than in 1938 by 444 cars and pulpwood was down by 37 cars, but all other groups showed increases. Live stock was up by 527 cars, coal by 1,740 cars, coke by 380 cars, lumber by 1,007 cars, pulp and paper by 563 cars, other forest products by 184 cars, ore by 233 cars, merchandise by 746 cars and miscellaneous by 2,116 cars.

Total loadings in the eastern division rose from 32,777 cars last year to 37,265 cars and in the western division from 29,090 cars to 31,617 cars.




