Car loadings for the week ended October 21 amounted to 62,345 cars compared with 60,079 cars for the previous week and 62,095 cars for the corresponding week last year. Light loading of western grain due to accumulations at elevators was an important factor in the week's loading. The decrease in grain in the western division was 1,392 cars from the previous week's and 4,799 cars from last year's.

The holiday in the previous week affected comparisons but the index adjusted for such factors declined from 82.11 to 79.92. Compared with last year's loadings for both divisions, grain was down by 5,388 cars, but all other groups showed increases as follows: live stock 69 cars, coal 426 cars, coke 334 cars, lumber 940 cars, pulpwood 364 cars, pulp and paper 637 cars, other forest products 586 cars, ore 54 cars, merchandise 312 cars and miscellaneous 1,916 cars. Total loadings in the eastern division increased from 32,976 cars last year to 36,716 cars and in the western division the total decreased from 29,119 cars to 25,629 cars.




