## CAR LOADINGS

Vol. XVI.

(Forty-third Week Ended October 28, 1939)

Car loadings for the week ended October 28 declined to 59,903 cars from 62,345 cars for the previous week and the index number dropped from 79.92 to 74.86. The decrease was all in the western division where grain loadings continued light due to congestion at the elevators.

Total loadings for the western division declined to 23,087 cars from 25,629 cars for the previous week and 26,074 cars for the corresponding week last year, and the index number dropped from 80.77 for the previous week to 70.40.

Total loadings in the eastern division increased to 36,816 cars from 36,716 cars for the previous week and 31,859 cars for the corresponding week last year.


Losdingsin all groups were heavier in the eastern division than in 1938 but in the western division a decrease of 4,497 cars of grain, 264 cars of coal and 6 cars of pulpwood more than offset increases in the other groups.


