

**CAR LOADINGS**

Car loadings for the week ended July 11 amounted to 66,789 cars as compared with 65,128 cars for the corresponding week last year.

Loadings of grain in the western division were lighter than in 1941 by 2,573 cars and coke, lumber, pulpwood, pulp and paper and ore also showed decreases but these were more than offset by increases of 1,311 cars of coal; 1,288 cars of miscellaneous; 339 cars of live stock; and smaller increases in other groups raising the total for the division to 21,244 cars as against 21,076 cars in 1941.


In the eastern division grain was down by 142 cars, live stock by 46 cars, coal by 952 cars, pulpwood by 245 cars and merchandise by 221 cars, but miscellaneous was heavier by 2,453 cars, ore by 844 cars, lumber by 822 cars, pulpwood by 710 cars, other forest products by 205 cars and coke by 83 cars, raising the total to 45,545 cars as against 42,052 cars a year ago.


