Car loadings on Canadian railways in the holiday week ending December 31st totalled 49,063 cars compared with 52,419 cars in the closing week of last year, off 3,356 cars.

Storm conditions in the western division caused delay in the loading and movement of freight, particularly in the mountain regions of British Columbia where heavy snow and extreme cold were experienced while the coastal area suffered from flash floods which undermined roadbed. Due to the irregularities of the present calendar, comparisons with previous years are somewhat disturbed. The Christmas holiday fell in the last week of 1949 whereas in 1948 and 1947 New Year's Day was in the last period, and consequently the index numbers are affected.

Eastern division loadings during the last week of 1949 were 34,590 cars against 35,491 one year earlier, while the western division beset by snow, cold and floods contributed 14,473 cars compared with 16,928 cars in the 52nd week of 1948.

Loadings of most commodities were lighter in the week under review with only fresh meats, lumber, gasoline and petroleum oils, autos and trucks, and fertilizers registering significant gains over the last week of 1948. Gasoline and oils at 4,038 cars were up from 3,307 while autos jumped from 885 to 1,395 cars as the last of the year's models rolled from most plants.

Cumulative totals for the 52 weeks of 1949 show some 3,906,655 cars of revenue freight loaded on Canadian railways compared with 4,038,456 cars in 1948 and 3,947,817 cars in a similar period of 1947. The decline from 1948 was 3.3 p.c. or 131,801 cars, while a minor recession of 41,162 cars was experienced from the 1947 volume.

Receipts from foreign connections were down sharply during 1949 and at 1,597,056 compare with 1,790,081 cars in 1948 and 1,918,122 cars in 1947.

Western division loadings during the year improved over both 1948 and 1947 due to wheat, ores, and Alberta oil, while the eastern division volume showed a 5.8 p.c. drop from 1948 and were 3 p.c. under 1947.

Total cars of revenue freight loaded on railways in the United States during 1949 were some 16 p.c. below 1948 due principally to strikes in steel and coal whereas the Canadian experience shows a recession of only 3.3 p.c. from 1948.


