

CAR LOADINGS

(Fourteenth week ended April 8, 1950)

Car loadings during the week ending Easter Saturday totalled 63,594 cars and were affected by the Good Friday holiday. During the week ended April 9th last year 71,997 cars were loaded.

Despite the shorter week, gains were shown over the 14th period of 1949 in the movement of hay and straw, fresh fruits, vegetables, base bullion, lumber, gasoline and crude oil, autos and trucks and woodpulp and paper. Grain loadings have continued at much lower levels.

Receipts from foreign connections during the 14th week amounted to 33,508 cars compared with 32,528 cars in the corresponding week of 1949. United States loadings were considerably above last year during March.

Eastern division reported 41,768 cars loaded during the holiday week compared with 47,421 in 1949 while western volume was 21,826 against 24,576 cars. On a daily average basis loadings were heavier in the week under review.

Total loadings in the first 14 weeks were 958,146 cars compared with 1,016,193 in 1949 and 1,027.724 cars in the similar period of 1948. Fruit, coal, hay and straw, fresh meats, other mine products. lumber. gasoline and crude oil, autos, woodpulp and paper, canned foods, were moved in greater volume this year, while grain was off sharply from 90,647 to 65,008 cars, and ores, building products, logs, pulpwood off from 74,513 to 49,428 cars, sugar, implements, iron and steel and L.C.L. merchandise were reduced.
