CAR LOADINGS

(Fortieth week ended October 7, 1950)

No. 40

Cars of revenue freight loaded at 89,273 during the 40th week declined 1,703 cars from the preceding period but were 191 cars above the 89,082 reported for the 40th week of last year. Eastern division activity continued at record levels and 57,578 cars were readied compared with 53,724 cars in the corresponding period of 1949, a gain of 7.2 p.c. Western loadings were affected by a touch of winter whose vanguards brought early frost and some fleeting snows to northern districts and only 31,695 cars were loaded against 35,358 cars last year as grain, live stock, coal, gasoline and L.C.L. were down considerably. Among the Canada totals, betterment over the same week of last year was indicated in ores and concentrates up from 3,657 to 5,322 cars, base bullion, building products 552 cars heavier, other mine products, logs, pulpwood up from 2,193 to 3,268 cars, lumber at 5,689 cars against 4,134, and in other forest products. Gasoline increased fractionally but crude oil rose from 1,444 to 1,626 cars. Iron and steel manufactures moved in 2,078 carloads compared with 1,721 in the same period of 1949. Autos and trucks totalled 1,417 carloads against 1,361. Woodpulp and paper produced 4,571 cars, or 469 more than last year. Other manufactures and miscellaneous supplied 6,474 cars, up 698 carloads.

The main declines were in products of farm, garden and orchard. Grain dropped from 10,909 to 8,104 cars with a late harvest adversely affected by early frost. Vegetables were off from 1,410 to 845 cars and other agricultural products down 606 cars to 816. Live stock, reflecting price drops, decreased sharply at 1,877 cars against 2,724 last year. Dairy products totalled 90 cars, off from 237. Coal and coke were both lower with coal down 903 carloads to 7,262 for the week. L.C.L. merchandise grossed 18,353 cars compared to 18,834 one year earlier.

Receipts from foreign connections were heavier again at 35,312 cars against 30,834 in the same week of 1949.

Despite the 9-day rail strike towards the end of August, cumulative totals for the 40 weeks of the current year show 2,926,282 cars loaded,down only 61,530 from the similar period of 1949. Foreign receipts at 1,236,825 cars compare favourably with 1,230,949 cars to October 8th last year and should be encouraged by the recent freeing of Canadian currency and easing of import restrictions.
