The closing period of March showed 98,876 cars of revenue freight loaded by Canadian railways with a daily average of 9,888 cars, which was deflated somewhat by the occurrence of two Sundays. Loadings in the Eastern division were 68,083 cars while the West contributed 30,793 to the national total. Receipts from connections grossed 49,996 cars for the ten-day period compared with 36,921 in the seven days ended March 21st.

Compared with the similar period of 1951, available records show greatly increased loadings of grain while other mine products, logs, implements and tractors, etc., and fertilizers were moved in better volume. The majority of agricultural items were down sharply due to the livestock embargoes. Coal was much lighter while building products have not regained last year's volume and shipments of autos and trucks are considerably reduced as well as miscellaneous manufactures and L.C.L. merchandise.

A cumulative comparison is now possible with the first quarter of 1951 and shows total loadings to the end of March this year at 979,627 cars against 961,948 cars one year ago. The increase was confined to the Western division where grain advanced 56,079 cars to 87,642 cars. Receipts from connections registered a minor gain of 5,071 cars to 474,364. Declines outnumbered gains during the first quarter as compared with last year. Livestock declined from 15,592 to 12,299 cars. Coal, coke and ores were also lighter, as were building products and other mine products. Logs and pulpwood improved considerably with pulpwood rising 13,756 cars to 94,446, but lumber shipments dropped 8,790 cars to 42,047. Gasoline, iron and steel,implements and fertilizers posted gains for the quarter while autos and trucks were off 430 carloads to 20,350. Miscellaneous items slipped 7,176 cars at 64,056 and L.C.L. continued downward 15,646 cars to 192,656.
