In the first seven days of May Canadian railways loaded 80,631 cars of revenue freight. The daily average of 11,519 was down from the closing period of April at 12,188 cars and under approximately the corresponding period of 1951. Eastern volume amounted to 52,774 cars, while the western region reported 27,857 cars for the week. Receipts from connections during the first week of the month totalled 34,240 cars registering improvement over the same time last year.

Grain loadings during the week under review were 10,531 cars or about 9 p.c. above 1951 levels. Gains were also indicated in other agricultural and other packing house products. Ores and concentrates at 3,458 cars, non-ferrous metals and other mine products were moved in better volume. Logs and other forest products posted increases while pulpwood and lumber shipments were lighter. Gasoline and petroleum oil and products showed considerable heavier loadings with a total of 5,518 cars. Implements and machinery were also better, according to the available comparisons. The major declines were in fresh fruits at only 44 cars with most of the crop movement completed. Vegetables were reduced, as well livestock at 1,146 cars. Coal and coke continued lower. Iron and steel and autos posted minor declines, but fertilizers were off considerably at 1,431 cars. Miscellaneous items and L. C. L. merchandise shipments were down from a year ago.

The cumulative total to May 7th shows 1,385,984 cars of revenue freight loaded at stations in Canada and 648,759 cars received from connections, indicating a near record volume of traffic in the first 17 periods of the current year. STATISTICS
