Activity in railway carloading during the seven day onded Jun $2 l e t$ continued fairly good with 82,343 care of revenue frelght reported from Canadion etatione, a daily average of 11,763 cars compared vith 11,540 cart one week earlier, when 80,780 care were shown.

The western division from the liead of the Lakes to the Coast loaded 27, 234 cars, off 647 care, dopite heavier grain hipmente but with lighter ore and lumber doliverise. In the east the week total was 55,109 cars, up from 52,899 cert in the previous week with cosl, bulldig producte, pulpwood and iumber better.

Recelpte from forelgn connections, affected by the crippling teel strike in the United States nov anterlag 1 ti 11 th week, momited to 29,993 cars, down from 31,682 cers in the period ended Jume $14 t h$.

Comparien available with the period aded June 21 et of last jear indicate considerable betterment in grain loadigg which vers increaged over $20 \mathrm{p} \cdot \mathrm{c}$; fresh meate, coke, oree end concentraten, non-ferrous vetale, building products, gasolime and petrolem ofly, automobiles, and fertilizors also joined in the advance. The major recesions occorred in rogetablee, liveetock, coal, pulpwood, lumber, crude oil, sugar and miscollaneout maufactures. Yoodpulp and paper vere likewiae below 1951.
