S U M M A R Y  
OF  
MONTHLY TRAFFIC REPORTS  
FOR  
YEAR ENDED DECEMBER 31ST, 1925

The data in the following tables include only the revenue freight carried by the railways in Canada and not coal and other commodities used by the railways. Consequently discrepancies will appear when comparing these data with data on imports and exports. Also, on account of the absence of data on waterborne traffic, the net imports and net exports for the several provinces are incomplete and are correct only from a railway traffic view point.

When grain is delivered to elevators it is reported as unloaded at the stations but is not reported again as loaded when reshipped by boat. In this way Ontario shows a heavy importation of grain whereas most of it moves from the head of the lakes to Montreal or other Canadian and United States ports. In the same way grain arriving at Montreal by rail is shown as unloaded in Quebec but no offsetting entry is made when it is reloaded into vessels. In the Prairie Provinces, however, where practically all transportation of freight is by rail, the data quite accurately show the movements into and out of the provinces.

The total revenue tonnage handled by the railways during 1925 exceeded the 1924 tonnage by 2,588,463 tons, agricultural products accounting for only 387,356 tons of this increase. The large carry-over of the 1923 grain crop into 1924 and the lighter crop in 1924 with a smaller carry-over into 1925 was the main cause of this relatively small increase; at the end of July agricultural products carried were 3,175,404 tons less than for the first seven months of 1924 but with the big 1925 harvest the shipments in the last five months overcame this deficit and produced a gain of 387,356 tons. Animal products were 58,380 tons less than in 1924 being lighter every month except January - June, July, October and November. The labour troubles in the Nova Scotia and United States mines affected the coal traffic and although coke, ores, gravel and crushed stone, etc. showed increases, the total tonnage of mine products handled was 260,796 tons less than during the previous year. Forest products were light during March, April and May but made gains in the other months, the net result being an increase of 187,215 tons; 123,258 tons of this increase was in United States freight passing through Canada.

The largest increase over the previous year's traffic was made in the manufactures and miscellaneous group which aggregated 24,136,520 tons or 2,333,068 tons over 1924 tonnage and was only 63,613 tons below the 1923 tonnage. Compared with 1924 tonnage the freight in this group loaded at stations in Canada increased 1,023,692 tons, or 7.5 per cent, the imports increased 161,206 tons, or 6.5 per cent and foreign freight passing through Canada increased 1,148,170 tons, or 20 per cent. Import of automobiles showed an increase of 39,342 tons and of refined petroleum and its products, 48,065 tons, and the tonnage of automobiles passing through Canada increased 455,206 tons. Wood pulp loaded at Canadian stations was 335,580 tons heavier than in 1924 and paper and printed matter was 164,705 tons heavier; 80 per cent of the total tonnage of these two commodities was delivered to United States railways. Of the pulpwood carried, approximately one half was unloaded at Canadian stations and one half delivered to foreign connections. Also the greater part of the flour, dressed meats, canned meats, poultry, eggs and butter and cheese, in car load lots, was export traffic.
