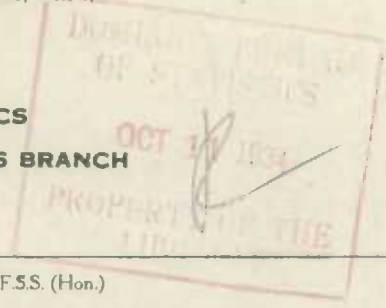

MONTHLY TRAFFIC REPORT OF RAILWAYS OF CANADA

JULY, 1934

Canadian railways carried 5,493,412 tons of freight during July, which was 18.5 per cent above the total of 4,634,654 tons carried in July, 1933. More than half of this increase was in mine products which rose from 1,373,130 tons to 1,852,426 tons. Bituminous coal was heavier by 207,512 tons, or 36 per cent. Iron ore and copper ore and concentrates showed decreases, but other ores were up by 99,855 tons, or 113 per cent. Base bullion, matte, pig and ingot increased by 15,215 tons, or 38 per cent, sand and gravel by 64,758 tons, or 94 per cent, and crushed stone increased by 84,926 tons, or 161 per cent. Agricultural products accounted for 200,529 tons of the total increase, wheat being heavier by 226,358 tons and barley by 9,359 tons, but corn, oats, rye, flaxseed, other grain and flour were lighter than in 1933. Animal products showed an increase of 7,328 tons, or 3.8 per cent, and forest products an increase of 32,743 tons, or 5.8 per cent. Lumber, timber, box, crate and cooperage material showed a decrease of 44,993 tons which was the first decrease recorded since April, 1933. Manufactures and miscellaneous freight was 10.3 per cent heavier than in July, 1933; tonnage loaded at Canadian stations increased by 121,383 tons and imports by 19,542 tons, but in-transit freight decreased by 2,135 tons. Freight loaded and received from foreign connections, by provinces, show the following percentages of increase over July, 1933: Prince Edward Island, 12; Nova Scotia, 55; New Brunswick, 33; Quebec, 10; Ontario, 12; Manitoba, 19; Saskatchewan, 11; Alberta, 43; and British Columbia, 11.
