MONTHLY TRAFFIC REPORT OF RAILWAYS OF CANADA

JAFUARY, 1936

Cenadian railways carried 5 376,624 tons of revenue freight during January, consisting of 3,624,405 tons loaded at Canadian stations, 777,469 tons imported and 874,750 tons of foreign freight passing through Canada. The loading of agricultural products in Nova Scotia, New Brunswick, Manitoba and Saskatchewan, particularly in the last two provinces, was considerably lighter than in 1935, but in Ontario and Alberta substantial increases were recorded. Loadings of forest products in Quebac were about cut in half, this decrease was largely in pulpwood, but in British Columbia forest products increased by 52 per cent. Total agricultural products tonnage for Canada increased by 149,077 tons, wheat being heavier by 179,430 tons and hay and straw being lighter by 45,525 tons. Animal products decreased by 9,851 tons or from 198,778 tons to 188,927 tons. Due to light imports of anthracite coal and loadings of bituminous and lignite coal these commodities recorded decreases of 30,293 tons, 84,092 tons and 56,424 tons respectively. Other ores and concentrates were up by 24,703 tons, coke by 24,816 tons and base bullion by 13,561 tone, but total mine products declined from 2,238,341 tons in January 1935 to 2,151,149 tons. Pulpwood declined by 83,824 tone, mostly in Quebec, and cordwood and firewood by 13,349 tone, but lumber timber, box, crate and cooperage material increased by 35,912 tons. Mamufactures and miscellaneous increased from 1,313,140 tons in 1935 to 1,404,187 tons. Automobiles and auto parts increased by 14,943 tons, newsprint paper by 9,775 tons, other paper by 6,483 tone wood pulp by 5,768 tone and building materials, cement, brick, lime and plaster also showed Sugar, fertilizers and cannod goods recorded losses of 7.168 tons, 6.351 tons and wubstantial increases. 6.058 tons respectively.
