MONTHLY TRAFFIC REPORT OF RAILWAYS OF CANADA

MARCH, 1944.

Revenue freight loaded at Canadian stations and received from foreign connections during March amounted to 15,525,007 tons as compared with 12,825,988 tons in March, 1945 and 10,605,660 tons in March, 1942. Loadings increased by 575,209 tons or 6.9 per cent. Wheat was particularly heavy, increasing over loadings in 1945 by 654,505 tons or 86.5 per cent. Oats and barley were considerably below the loadings of December and January and also below March 1945 loadings. Rye and flaxseed, although more than double the 1945 loadings, were lighter than in the three preceding months. Apples also fell off but potatoes increased. Loading of hogs has been heavy since last October and has averaged close to 60,000 tons per month as against an average of 56,000 tons per month for October, 1942 to March, 1945, and was almost twice as heavy as two years previous. Dressed meats have also showed much heavier loadings than in 1945 and 1942. Rails and fastenings, which have been light for some time, increased to 26,419 tons. This is the first month since May 1958 that they have exceeded 20,000 tons. For September 1945 to March 1944 the monthly average loading was 16,526 tons, whereas for the previous eight months it was only 5,695 tons. Loading of iron and steel (bar-sheet-structural-pipe) declined from 166,171 tons in March, 1945 to 116,918 tons. Castings, machinery and boilers also showed decreased loadings. Loadings of automobiles, trucks and parts amounted to 215,805 tons, which has been exceeded only by 228,025 tons in August and 215,051 tons in July, 1945, and compares with 52,957 tons in March, 1959. These include both civilian and military vehicles.
