MONTHLY TRAFFIC REPORT OF RAILWAYS OF CANADA

JANUARY, 1948

Revenue freight loaded at stations in Canada and received from foreign connections during January totalled 11,599,866 tons, an increase of 87,396 tons or .76 p.c. over January, 1947 and 479,000 tons above January of 1946 to establish a peacetime record for the month and was exceeded only by January 1944. However, loadings of animal, mine and forest products and manufactures and miscellaneous more than offset a decline of 220,345 tons from January 1947 in agricultural products. Freight loaded at stations in Canada actually was an all time record for the month but receipts from foreign connections declined 355,214 tons from the same month of 1947, and 684,156 tons from January 1944 when intramovement movements were heavy.

Increases over January last year were recorded in wheat, barley, flaxseed, cattle, hogs and eggs; and in lignite coal, copper, and in other ores, crude petroleum and other mine products. Pulpwood advanced 189,950 tons and lumber 33,143. Gasoline was up 24,504 tons, iron and steel 28,796 and wood pulp 11,651 tons. The main recessions were in loadings of corn, flour, other mill products, anthracite and bituminous coal, salt, canned goods and l.c.l. merchandise which declined 10,855 tons due to reduced receipts from foreign connections.

With the current issue a new monthly table is presented which gives the provincial distribution of freight loaded and unloaded at stations in each province. It is felt that this table will be useful as a measure of economic activity on a regional basis and will make possible more detailed studies on the trend of commodity movements from month to month. For example, the unloadings of manufactured products in the four western provinces in January totalled 450,609 tons while 396,655 tons were loaded.
