MONTHLY TRAFFIC REPORT OF RAILWAYS OF CANADA

DECEMBER, 1948

The tonnage of revenue freight carried by Canadian railways during December aggregated 12,345,498 tons compared with 13,013,397 tons in the same month of 1947. The decline was thus 667,899 tons or 5.4 p.c. Loadings at Canadian stations receded from 9,300,226 to 9,079,612 tons or by 220,614 tons, while receipts from foreign connections were down more sharply from 3,713,171 tons in December, 1947 to 3,265,886 tons in the month under review, a drop of 447,285 tons, or 13.7 p.c. Foreign freight destined to Canadian points was 1,735,940 tons compared with 1,955,242 tons one year earlier, the principal decline being in bituminous coal imports, but all groups other than mine products registered increases. Loadings of agricultural products in Canada showed improvement over the previous December, totalling 2,153,527 tons against 2,115,674 tons. The wheat movement was some 174,000 tons heavier; oats, flour, cotton, apples and other agricultural products registered increases but rye, flaxseed and other mill products dropped considerably. Cattle shipments were up over the previous December but hogs, dressed meats and poultry, butter, eggs and cheese, were down, the total for animal and animal products declining by 41,602 tons to 171,611 tons for the month. Canadian mine products showed an encouraging gain at 3,022,535 tons against 2,787,527 tons with most items advancing. Crude petroleum was more than double the previous December at 74,980 tons compared with 33,962 tons. Loadings of forest products dropped considerably from 1,442,305 to 1,099,341 tons off 23.8 p.c. with pulpwood down 168,335 tons and lumber less 145,200 tons. The manufactures and miscellaneous group total receded from 2,741,507 in December, 1947, to 2,652,598 tons, or by 108,909 tons although gains were recorded in gasoline, sugar, pig iron, cement, agricultural implements, automobiles and fertilizers. Newsprint shipments were 353,249 tons against 357,269 tons one year earlier. L.C.L. freight declined 32,140 tons to 237,568.

Compared with the previous December, only the provinces of Nova Scotia and Manitoba reported increased volume. The total for Quebec was down from 2,394,151 to 2,000,107 tons, Ontario from 5,679,290 to 5,458,678 tons, Alberta from 1,310,871 to 1,254,197 tons while British Columbia reported a decline of 18,669 tons with 877,119 tons carried during the month. By classification group only agricultural products registered a gain over the volume transported on all railways throughout Canada in December, 1947.

Cumulative totals of all revenue freight carried for the twelve months of 1948 reached 154,732,409 tons compared with 152,705,372 tons in 1947, a gain of 1.5 p.c. or 2,027,037 tons. A detailed analysis of the year's figures will be given in the Bureau's "Summary of Monthly Railway Traffic Reports" which will appear later. The 1948 originated volume was the second highest on record, second only to the 1944 total of 154,845,277 tons.
