MONTHLY TRAFFIC REPORT OF RAILWAYS OF CANADA

FEBRUARY, 1948

The movement of freight on Canadian railways during February continued at record levels. Total revenue freight loaded at stations in Canada and received from foreign connections reached 11,288,511 tons, an increase of nearly 11 p.c. or 1,116,030 tons over the same month of 1947. This is a peacetime high for the month and advances were registered over February 1947, in all provinces except Alberta where mine products declined. The grand total of 11,288,511 tons was comprised of 8,060,175 tons loaded at stations in Canada, 1,686,825 received destined to Canadian points and 1,541,513 tons intransit between foreign stations. This division compares with 6,869,574 tons loaded at Canadian stations in February 1947, 1,755,906 tons received from foreign connections for delivery in Canada and 1,547,001 tons intransit. There is a significant decline of 69,085 tons in imports, principally in agricultural, mine and forest products, against an increase of 1,190,801 tons in Canadian loadings.

Advances in loadings in Canada over February 1947 were shown in wheat up 250,914 tons at 695,614, barley doubled at 150,457 tons, and potatoes 49,629 tons against 54,845. Cattle loadings improved slightly but hogs increased 9,264 tons to 28,324. Meats moved in heavier volume and butter advanced 1,771 tons to 2,984 tons for the month. Bituminous coal rose 156,542 tons to 595,256 but sub-bituminous dropped 105,615 tons to 125,719 tons. Ores moved in much greater volume and crude petroleum aggregated 52,641 tons against 10,575 tons in February of last year.

Total forest products were 1,764,154 compared with 1,481,647 tons, pulpwood increasing by 175,064 tons and lumber up 96,490 tons. The manufactures and miscellaneous group rose from 2,228,182 to 2,454,124 tons for the month under review, gains in gasoline and petroleum products, iron and steel, cement, agricultural implements, newsprint, wood pulp and other manufactures contrasting with declines in pig iron, automobiles, beverages, fertiliser and canned goods. L.C.L. freight was little changed at 255,950 tons. While February this year had 29 days, there were 5 Sundays and the number of "loading" days is thus comparable with 1947. In the first two months of 1948 a total of 22,886,177 tons of revenue freight were handled by Canadian railways, an increase of 1,205,426 tons or 5.55 p.c. over the same period of 1947.

The provincial distribution of freight loaded and unloaded during February indicates the higher level of business activity in all regions of Canada. The minor net decline from February, 1947 in Alberta of some 12,000 tons was attributable to reduced coal shipments, whereas the large increase in Nova Scotia reflects the settlement of the coal strike prevailing in 1947.

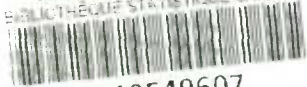
