MONTHLY TRAFFIC REPORT OF RAILWAYS OF CANADA

MAY, 1948

Canadian railways moved 12,239,205 tons of revenue freight during May, the second highest peacetime volume on record for the month. This, however, represented, a decline of 596,111 tons or 4.6 p.c. from the 1947 peak but was 1,753,711 tons above May, 1946. Flood conditions prevailing in the western division plus embargo warnings early in the month against a threatened rail strike in the United States, exerted a restraining influence on the shipment of perishables and other freight. Loadings at stations in Canada totalled 8,773,901 tons against 9,315,059 tons one year earlier, while receipts from foreign connections dropped nearly 55,000 tons to 3,465,304. The principal decline from May, 1947, was in agricultural products which sagged no less than 1,243,147 tons with wheat 733,253 tons lighter, oats down 185,276 tons, barley 42,806 tons, flour 72,759 tons and other mill products off 74,216 tons. The animal and animal products group declined 23,618 tons but cattle and calves improved 3,365 tons over the preceding May. Mine products rose 749,139 tons with bituminous coal up 399,298 tons, ores and concentrates 128,497 tons and stone 43,182 tons heavier. Pulpwood hauled during the month reached 606,537 tons, an increase of 78,695 tons over May, 1947. The manufactures group showed diverse tendencies with losses offsetting gains by 129,439 tons due to sharp recessions in the movement of petroleum, miscellaneous manufactures, and fertilizers.

Provincial loadings showed improvement over May, 1947, only in Nova Scotia where resumption of coal mining increased the total to 933,499 tons against 509,109 tons one year previous. The Quebec total of 1,692,251 tons for the month was little changed. Sharp declines were shown in agricultural products in all provinces. Saskatchewan total loadings dropped from 851,951 tons to 436,173. Alberta from 1,220,772 to 828,912 tons and Manitoba from 555,933 to 431,615 tons. Ontario was off 181,527 tons at 3,322,472 tons loaded at stations within the province during May, 1948.

Cumulative totals to the end of May show a peacetime record - 60,550,433 tons of revenue freight hauled by Canadian railways, an increase of 1,255,250 tons or 2.1 p.c. over the similar period of 1947. The greater activity in mine and forest more than compensated for a reduced crop movement. The majority of manufactured items moved in greater volume with gasoline, iron and steel, sugar, cement, building products, agricultural implements, wood pulp and other manufactures featured. L.C.L. freight, however, was 124,236 tons lighter to the end of May while automobiles were off 58,827 tons, canned goods 106,749 tons and petroleum oils 123,832 tons.

The rail movement of commodities in trade as reflected in loadings and unloadings by provinces reveals tonnage credits for Nova Scotia, New Brunswick, Alberta and British Columbia with Saskatchewan practically balanced. Details by individual commodities are given in the table "Provincial Distribution", pages 4 to 7.

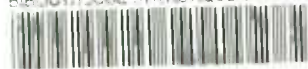
