MONTHLY TRAFFIC REPORT OF RAILWAYS OF CANADAJUNE, 1948

The tonnage of freight loaded at railway stations in Canada and received from foreign connections totalled 12,563,218 tons during June compared with 12,969,493 tons in the same month of last year, a decline of 3.1 p.c. Domestic loadings were down 268,305 tons while foreign receipts were 137,970 tons lighter. Loadings in Saskatchewan, Alberta and British Columbia were considerably below June 1947 levels due to the combination of greatly reduced available grain supplies and flood conditions which persisted until mid-month on the coast. Agricultural products were over a million tons under the preceding June at 1,711,822 tons compared with 2,714,847 and animal products declined from 228,000 to 217,458 tons. However, mineral output was greatly increased, advancing from 4,437,936 to 4,951,553 tons reflecting heavier movement of coal and various ores; forest products rose nearly 79,900 tons to 1,681,237 tons and the manufactures and miscellaneous group recorded 4,001,148 tons during the month, up 15,785 tons over the same period of 1947. Fourteen of the sixteen products listed under agriculture registered decreases from the previous June, wheat declining 573,495 tons to 715,836 tons, oats down 114,297 tons at 164,282, mill products off 66,854 tons at 228,316. The increased movement of cattle and calves, dressed meats and poultry, and wool contrasted with declines in shipments of horses, hogs, eggs, butter, cheese and packing house products. Cheese was 9,354 tons below June, 1947, at 7,620 tons, while horses principally for export declined from 12,873 to 7,012 tons originated. Imports of anthracite coal rose from 346,451 tons in June, 1947, to 336,187 tons in the month under review, while 550,751 tons of bituminous coal were imported and 726,106 tons supplied by Canadian mines to the railways for delivery against 496,020 tons from domestic sources one year earlier and 635,809 tons from the United States for use in Canada. In the first six months of this year the railways handled 2,629,786 tons or 148,029 tons more of anthracite and 8,113,038 tons or 1,419,280 more tons of bituminous coal than in the first half of 1947. Other ores and concentrates loaded at stations in Canada during June reached 449,706 tons compared with 374,764 tons a year previous. All building materials were moved in greater volume. Among the forest products pulpwood registered the principal gain with 633,266 tons loaded in Canada during the month, up 176,493 tons over June, 1947. However, logs, cordwood, ties and lumber moved in smaller tonnage. Gasoline shipments from Canadian refineries rose 60,689 tons to 330,897 tons during the month, iron and steel totalled 137,145 tons against 117,878 tons, cement increased from 129,215 to 149,901 tons loaded at Canadian stations, woodpulp was up 18,875 tons from June, 1947, to 179,741 tons. Recessions were shown in agricultural implements, furniture, beverages, automobiles, trucks and parts down from 49,833 to 37,963 tons, fertilizers off 38,768 tons at 95,267 tons, canned goods, other manufactures and miscellaneous off 39,556 tons. Domestic loadings of l.c.l. merchandise improved from 270,310 to 277,359 tons but imports were down 9,844 tons from the preceding June.

In the first six months of 1948 the railways hauled a peacetime record of 73,113,651 tons of freight, a gain of 848,975 tons or 1.2 p.c. over the same period of 1947. Of this total, mine products supplied 35.2 p.c., manufactures and miscellaneous 32.9 p.c., agricultural 16 p.c., forest 14.1 p.c., and animal products 1.8 p.c.

By provinces, excess of loadings over unloadings are indicated for Nova Scotia, New Brunswick, Saskatchewan, Alberta and British Columbia. Prince Edward Island loaded only 17,431 tons as against 39,296 tons in June, 1947.
