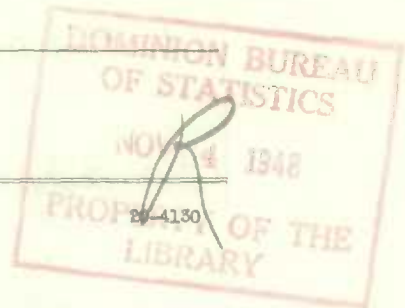

MONTHLY TRAFFIC REPORT OF RAILWAYS OF CANADA

JULY, 1948

The tonnage of revenue freight transported by Canadian railways during July aggregated 12,740,967 tons, comprising 9,323,594 tons of domestic loadings and 3,417,373 tons received from United States lines. The total compares with 13,168,053 tons handled in July of 1947 and 11,108,312 tons in July, 1946, and reflects a decline of about 3 p.c. from the record level of the same month last year when considerable quantities of grain and grain products were moving eastward and intransit traffic was heavier across Southern Ontario. Loadings at Canadian stations during the month were 9,323,594 against 9,721,104 tons in July, 1947, off 397,510 tons or 4 p.c. Wheat loadings declined from 1,148,688 to 653,203 tons, oats from 207,194 tons to 147,716, flour from 205,190 to 134,701 tons while the total of domestic agricultural products was down from 2,010,242 to 1,356,321 tons or by 33 p.c. Animal and animal products loaded in Canada receded from 137,913 to 120,496 tons in the July to July comparison. Canadian forest products also moved in lighter volume during the month under review with 1,731,558 tons loaded against 1,790,118 in July, 1947. However, encouraging gains were indicated in the volume of mine products transported at 3,322,445 tons compared with 3,124,839 tons and in the manufactures and miscellaneous group, up from 2,657,992 to 2,792,774 tons of domestic products. L.C.L. freight loaded advanced from 264,301 to 321,515 tons.

Commodities imported by rail from the United States to register a gain over July, 1947, included corn up from 3,900 to 7,604 tons, wool, anthracite coal up over 54,000 tons, bituminous coal 112,600 tons heavier at 655,791 tons, coke, and ores and concentrates up 150,000 tons. Declines were general among manufactured items and for most of the 76 commodities detailed in the report, but the total, heavily weighted by increased coal and ore imports, rose from 1,858,845 to 1,975,255 tons.

Provincial data indicate that only in Nova Scotia, Quebec, Alberta and British Columbia was a larger tonnage handled in July this year as compared with the same month of 1947. Prince Edward Island loaded 9,600 tons as against 12,565 tons, New Brunswick declined from 465,368 to 405,973 tons, while Saskatchewan sagged from 882,911 tons to 677,717 due to reduced grain shipments.

Cumulative figures for the first seven months show a grand total of 85,854,618 tons of freight transported, an increase of 421,589 tons or 0.5 p.c. over the same period of 1947. The principal commodities responsible for the advance were bituminous coal up 1,662,438 tons, coke up 131,546 tons, anthracite with a 228,453 tons increase, other ores and concentrates 728,655 tons heavier, other mine products up 537,358 tons, cement increasing 182,786 tons, pulpwood up 1,130,824 tons, other paper 91,823 tons heavier, and gasoline up 204,655 tons. However, agricultural products declined 4,221,449 tons from the first seven months of 1947 with wheat down 1,985,000 tons.

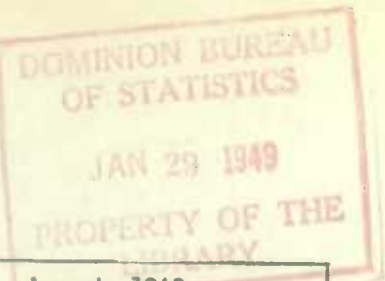

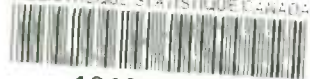
