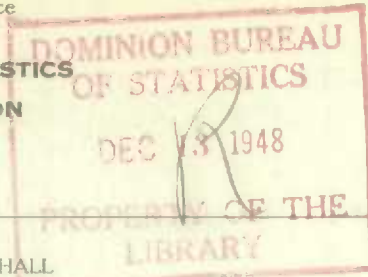

MONTHLY TRAFFIC REPORT OF RAILWAYS OF CANADA

AUGUST, 1948

Revenue freight carried by Canadian railways during August totalled 12,994,491 tons compared with the revised movement of 12,685,899 tons in July and 12,340,377 tons in August of 1947, indicating gains of 2.4 p.c. and 5.5 p.c., respectively. Loadings in Canada aggregated 9,211,567 tons for the month while 5,782,924 tons were received from United States lines and other foreign connections. Canadian loadings were up 212,584 tons over the preceding August, while foreign freight handled was up 441,730 tons in the same comparison with tonnage destined to Canadian stations, increasing some 447,600 tons against a small decline in the intranait volume.

The effect of an improved grain harvest was not yet apparent during the month and agricultural products carried were off 327,550 tons from the previous August, with heavy declines in oats, barley, flour, mill products and fruit. Cattle and calves were up 10,624 tons over the same month last year and fresh meats and poultry increased 5,873 tons. Mine products showed the greatest recovery, the total increasing 825,026 tons from 4,529,609 to 5,354,635 tons. Heavier imports of coal accounted for nearly half the advance, while Canadian mines were also more active. Iron ore dropped 237,419 tons but other ore and concentrates increased 244,060 tons over August, 1947. Building products moved in larger volume. Forest products were down 24,851 tons although pulpwood was up 42,910 tons. Gains predominated among manufactured products, the total for the group reaching 3,933,361 tons, up 4.8 p.c. or 180,760.

Gasoline, pig iron, iron and steel products, cement, automobiles, fertilizers, wood pulp and paper other than newsprint all showed encouraging advances over the previous August. L.C.L. loadings at Canadian stations were little changed at 259,648 tons against 259,822 tons one year earlier.

Imported freight showed sharp declines in corn, fruit and vegetables from August, 1947, as well as in packing house products. Coal, however, was up sharply as well as ores and concentrates, the total for the mine products group increasing from 1,280,505 tons to 1,801,113 tons destined to Canadian consumers. Imports of forest products were halved at 17,212 tons while manufactures declined from 371,073 to 330,902 tons.

Compared with August, 1947, loadings were heavier in all provinces except New Brunswick and Saskatchewan. Nova Scotia receipts increased 70,865 tons to 763,433 tons, Quebec was up over 202,200 tons, Ontario increased 227,813 tons, Manitoba from 531,034 to 625,637, Alberta from 849,342 to 919,415 and British Columbia from 826,359 to 962,553 or by 136,194 tons. Saskatchewan with lighter grain stocks available dropped 118,527 tons to 614,118 while New Brunswick was down over 30,400 tons at 391,536 for the month.

During the first 8 months of the year a total of 98,794,041 tons of revenue freight were carried on Canadian lines, an increase of 1,020,635 or 1 p.c. over the same period last year. Contributing to the increase were mine products up 4,290,086 tons, forest products 913,364 tons heavier, and manufactures and miscellaneous up 423,941 tons. However, the agricultural products group declined 4,548,999 tons in the same comparison and animals and animal products were off 57,757 tons. Wheat was down over 2,000,000 tons, while flour and other mill products combined declined over 1,000,000 tons from the first eight months of 1947.

Revisions received to July, 1948, statistics affecting one railway only are given on a supplementary sheet.
