MONTHLY TRAFFIC REPORT OF RAILWAYS OF CANADA

SEPTEMBER, 1948

Canadian railways transported a new record tonnage for the month of 14,521,997 tons during September, representing an increase of 656,141 tons or 4.8 p.c. over the same month of 1947. Revenue freight carried was up 1,397,978 tons over August due principally to the western grain movement. Loadings at stations in Canada were 10,786,948 tons compared with 9,982,678 in the previous September while receipts from foreign connections totalled 3,585,049 tons, little changed from September, 1947, at 3,685,178 tons. Foreign freight destined to Canadian customers increased from 2,042,158 tons to 2,042,648 tons but the intransit movement was lighter across Southern Ontario.

The movement of agricultural products was maintained at the levels of the previous September with an increase of only 746 tons on 3,007,474 tons. Advances in transport of wheat, rye, flaxseed, hay and straw and other fresh vegetables offset declines in 10 other commodities, notably barley, flour, other mill products, apples, other fruit and miscellaneous agricultural products. Cattle and calves moved in greater increased volume, the total at 103,151 tons reflecting an increase of 58,686 tons or more than double September of 1947. Dressed meats rose 12,016 tons to 57,572 tons for the month but most other animal products showed declines.

Mine products continued to show the greatest improvement of any group with a total of 5,550,501 tons or 563,603 tons more than in the preceding September. All items increased except iron ores and lignite coal. Anthracite was up 105,041 tons, while bituminous increased 191,569 tons to 1,556,820 tons for the month. Loadings of Canadian crude petroleum rose from 27,342 tons in September, 1947, to 71,446 tons or by 161 p.c. The forestry group featured an increase of 76,033 tons in pulpwood of which 584,950 tons were carried, lumber was up 8,042 tons to 719,171 but logs, posts, etc., and cordwood declined. Among the manufactured items, gasoline advanced from 300,899 to 323,152 tons and gains were registered over the previous September in sugar, pig iron, rails, iron and steel, cement, agricultural implements, fertilizers, other paper, wood pulp and fish. The most important decline was in autos, trucks and parts which were 36,479 tons lighter. Castings, brick, furniture, beverages, newsprint, canned goods, other manufactures and miscellaneous and L.C.L. freight showed recessions. The L.C.L. category declined 31,091 tons of which 27,972 tons occurred at Canadian stations.

Imports by freight to Canadian points registered losses in agricultural products, mainly in fruit and corn. Coal receipts, however, increased from 994,576 to 1,155,782 tons, lumber and timber dropped from 21,518 to 8,915 tons. Manufactures were 58,457 tons lighter, indicating reduced imports during the month of gasoline and oils, iron and steel, cement and building products, automobiles, trucks and parts, canned goods and miscellaneous.

By provinces, loadings were heavier than in September, 1947, in Nova Scotia, Ontario, Manitoba, Saskatchewan, Alberta and British Columbia. Quebec registered a minor decline of 0.1 p.c. New Brunswick loadings were off about 16,000 tons to 394,201 tons while Prince Edward Island loadings dropped from 19,905 to 8,109 tons due to declines in sand and gravel loaded, as well as in potatoes.

To the end of September, a total of 112,949,220 tons of revenue freight were carried by Canadian lines, an increase of 1,509,958 tons or 1.4 p.c. over the first nine months of 1947. Mine products up 4,686,871 tons this year offset a decline in agricultural products of 4,548,253 tons. Forest products increased 971,500 tons while manufactures improved by 394,000 tons in comparison with the same period of 1947.
