MONTHLY TRAFFIC REPORT OF RAILWAYS OF CANADA  
JANUARY, 1949

Revenue freight carried by Canadian railroads during January totalled 11,113,742 tons as against 11,599,866 in the similar period of 1948, a decline of 486,124 tons or 4.2 p.c. Loadings at stations in Canada were down only 1.2 p.c. or 94,279 tons at 8,202,591 tons, while receipts from foreign connections dropped by 391,845 tons to 2,911,151 tons, with both imports and intransit traffic lighter.

By commodity groups, agricultural products carried declined 194,832 tons to 1,995,620 tons for the month with wheat down 34,652 tons from January 1948, oats off 38,298 tons, barley less 51,600 tons, mill products 22,174 tons lighter and potatoes at 85,075 tons as against 105,574 tons. However, the movement of corn, cotton, apples and other fresh vegetables increased in volume. Animal products, reflecting declines in live stock, hogs, meats, eggs and butter, decreased 57,707 tons to 209,168. Forest products were down sharply from the preceding January with 1,312,960 tons as against 1,680,130 tons, pulpwood receding nearly 256,000 tons, while lumber was 95,666 tons below the same month of 1948.

However, mine products increased from 3,849,066 to 3,919,654 tons or by 70,588 tons with the principal gain in other ores and concentrates. The total coal movement was lighter. Copper ores, sand and gravel and other mine products advanced. Manufactures and miscellaneous improved by 62,997 tons to 3,678,340 with 10 items showing increases and 15 showing declines. Gasoline, pig iron, sugar, iron and steel, cement, agricultural implements, automobiles and newsprint paper registered good gains over January, 1948, while L.C.L., fertilizers, petroleum oils, wood pulp, fish and other manufactures were moved in smaller volume.

Loadings in Canada indicate improved loadings of domestic coal and reduced imports. Crude petroleum jumped from 32,096 tons in January, 1948, to 82,351 tons in the month under review, a measure of the increased production in the Alberta field.

By provinces, fair gains over 1948 were shown in Nova Scotia, Alberta and British Columbia, while Prince Edward Island rose only 24 tons. New Brunswick volume was down 113,610 tons to 428,434 tons, Quebec receded from 2,034,002 to 1,701,289 tons, Ontario was off 103,885 tons to 5,122,690, Manitoba traffic was 38,065 tons lighter at 344,209 tons and Saskatchewan dropped 60,446 tons to 643,227 tons in the current January.
