MONTHLY TRAFFIC REPORT OF RAILWAYS OF CANADA

NOVEMBER, 1949

Revenue freight transported by Canadian railways during November totalled 12,810,141 tons compared with 14,565,078 tons in the preceding November and 13,223,556 tons in the corresponding month of 1947. The decline from the 1948 peak for the month was 1,754,937 tons or 13.1 p.c. Loadings at Canadian points were 10,007,537 tons against 10,783,751 tons, down 776,414 tons, while receipts from foreign connections shrank more sharply from 3,718,327 tons to 2,802,804 tons, due mainly to the coal strikes in the United States. Foreign freight for Canadian delivery declined from 2,055,675 tons to 1,504,746, while intransit shipments dropped 427,594 tons from the preceding November volume to 1,298,058 tons during the month.

A comparison with total freight carried in November of 1948 indicates reduced volume in the five main commodity groups. Agricultural products eased from 3,444,794 tons to 3,156,406, a decrease of 288,588 tons with large declines in oats, barley, rye, flaxseed, fresh fruit, potatoes and fresh vegetables. Barley dropped from 325,681 to 184,222 tons. Gains were mainly in wheat, corn, other grain and miscellaneous agricultural products.

Animals and animal products were 30,025 tons lighter at 271,195 tons with live stock down 25,556 tons to 92,597 tons for the month. Hogs and dressed meats improved in volume. Mine products decreased 463,217 tons to 4,797,441 tons in November. Bituminous coal movements were reduced from 1,456,026 to 1,209,413 tons although total Canadian loadings of all domestic coal advanced. The decline was in receipts of American anthracite and bituminous. Domestic lignite rose from 117,794 to 209,033 tons. Decreased volume was shown for coke receipts. Other ores and concentrates dropped 227,967 tons to 552,419 tons, sand and gravel was off 69,567 tons to 264,582 while stone and other mine products were also lighter. Iron ore and crude petroleum registered good gains over November, 1948, with crude up from 111,124 to 159,729 tons. Here foreign receipts shrank from 41,509 to 2,775 tons as domestic production boomed. Forest products continued at lower levels with all items except ties reduced. Pulpwood declined 141,395 tons to 285,892 tons for the month and lumber was down from 655,465 to 596,257 tons. The group total at 1,082,873 tons for November was 252,175 tons or 18.9 p.c. below November of 1948.

The manufactures and miscellaneous group registered widespread reductions with the tonnage of 21 commodities lower and only 4 higher than the previous November. The principal declines were in pig iron from 93,504 to 52,902 tons, iron and steel off 106,522 tons to 148,372 with sharply reduced foreign receipts, automobiles down 51,582 tons to 138,795, beverages, newsprint, woodpulp, canned foods, other manufactures and miscellaneous 287,406 tons lighter at 1,045,569 tons and in L.C.L merchandise which shrank 50,997 tons from 547,617 to 296,620 tons.

Provincial loadings in Canada show declines from November 1948 in all provinces except Saskatchewan and Prince Edward Island. The Maritimes reported 1,221,316 tons loaded against 1,309,095 tons one year earlier, Quebec volume at 1,470,445 tons was down 198,632 tons, Ontario dropped from 3,624,870 to 3,171,623 tons loaded, the Prairies were less affected at 3,275,033 tons against 3,285,452 tons in the preceding November, while British Columbia eased from 905,676 to 858,501 tons.

The cumulative total of all revenue freight carried during the first 11 months of 1949 was 130,866,355 tons, down 11,518,556 tons or 8.1 p.c. from the same period of 1948, which had been a record in the history of Canadian railroading.
