MONTHLY TRAFFIC REPORT OF RAILWAYS OF CANADA

FEBRUARY, 1949

Canadian railways transported 10,990,657 tons of revenue freight during February compared with 11,115,742 tons in January and 11,288,511 tons in February of 1948 which had an extra day. Thus, the average tonnage carried daily in the current month was 392,525 tons against 389,252 tons in February last year, an increase of 0.8 p.c.

Loadings at Canadian stations advanced from 8,060,175 tons to 8,185,958 tons but receipts from foreign connections which had been 5,228,136 tons in February, 1948, receded to 2,804,699 tons in the month under review. Imports to Canadian points dropped from 1,686,823 tons to 1,404,481, while the intransit movement across Canada between American stations declined 141,095 tons to 1,400,218 tons.

Loadings in Canada increased over February, 1948, only in the mine products division which rose from 2,109,422 tons to 2,647,004 tons. Animal and animal products receded from 144,422 to 94,249 tons, agricultural was down nearly 140,000 tons to 1,448,230 tons, while forest products loaded dropped from 1,764,134 to 1,650,754 tons. The tonnage of manufactured and miscellaneous was off slightly on a daily average basis

Among total freight carried, commodities to register gains over 1948 included wheat up 81,442 tons to 801,815 tons during the month, corn 17,871 tons heavier at 89,935, flaxseed and cotton. Bituminous coal was up 65,084 tons to 1,296,482, while sub-bituminous rose 161,300 tons to 285,019 tons. Lignite and coke were also carried in greater volume. Other ores and concentrates totalled 575,146 tons, up 120,223 tons over the previous February. Crude petroleum advanced from 105,238 to 132,419 tons. Canadian loadings were 100,016 tons against 32,841 and imports dropped from 72,277 to 32,376 tons. The movement of logs, posts, poles and piling increased 19,625 tons to 175,761 tons, but other products of the forest were down sharply. Among manufactures, gasoline, sugar, pig iron, rails, iron and steel, cement, automobiles, brick and newsprint paper were transported in better volume than in February, 1948, but petroleum oils, castings and agricultural implements, furniture, beverages, fertilizers, wood pulp, fish, canned goods, miscellaneous and other manufactures and all L.C.L. freight were down considerably. L.C.L. freight carried by all lines totalled 270,425 tons, off 54,837 tons or 16.9 p.c.

By provincial areas, tonnage loaded improved over the same month last year in Prince Edward Island, Nova Scotia, Ontario, Saskatchewan, Alberta and British Columbia. The gain in Alberta was impressive, from 797,615 to 999,919 tons, due to greatly increased coal and petroleum shipments, the latter climbing from 32,156 tons in February, 1948, to 97,147 tons. Coal loadings and other mine products were up in Nova Scotia, while more potatoes moved out of Prince Edward Island. Forest products were down considerably in all provinces except Nova Scotia and Quebec. Recession in loadings of animals and animal products was country-wide. Manufactures and miscellaneous loadings were lighter in all provinces but New Brunswick and Alberta.

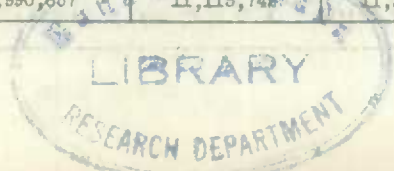
