MONTHLY TRAFFIC REPORT OF RAILWAYS OF CANADA
APRIL, 1949

Revenue freight carried by Canadian railways during April totalled 11,337,127 tons, off 845,248 tons or 6.9 p.c. from the similar period of 1948. Loadings at Canadian stations aggregated 8,603,549 tons compared with 8,968,477 tons in the previous April, down 4.1 p.c., while receipts from foreign connections declined from 5,211,898 to 2,733,778 tons reflecting a decreased volume of imports and intransit freight. The comparable recession during the month in domestic loadings in the United States was considerably greater than in Canada.

Increases over April, 1948, in Canadian loadings of revenue freight were shown only in agricultural products which rose from 1,505,048 to 2,079,940 tons, due mainly to wheat advancing 600,743 tons to 1,264,558 tons for the month. Grains such as barley, rye, corn and flaxseed were heavier, but flour shipments were down sharply from 157,256 to 127,578 tons and other mill products from 198,061 to 130,589 tons. Animal products, reflecting declines in hogs, dressed meats, eggs, hides, etc., were off 32,615 tons to 108,840 tons during April.

Among mine products, the total coal movement over Canadian lines dropped some 552,000 tons from April, 1948, with considerable reduction in the imports of anthracite as well as in the bituminous shipments from Canadian mines. However, Canadian loadings of iron ores improved from 56,160 to 72,219 tons and copper ores from 174,000 to 181,524 tons. Sand and gravel increased 23,379 tons and crude petroleum registered a spectacular advance from 36,896 tons to 139,976 tons, mainly in the Alberta field.

Forest products from Canadian points weighed 937,663 tons compared with 1,359,547 tons one year earlier. Pulpwood sagged from 661,997 to 581,012 tons while lumber dropped 93,559 tons to 416,918 tons, including plywood.

Among the manufactures and miscellaneous group gains over April, 1948, were shown in gasolins, up 45,465 tons from domestic sources to 256,517 tons, sugar, pig iron and iron and steel, cement from 155,855 to 195,245 tons, agricultural implements and fertilizers. Canadian loadings of brick, automobiles, petroleum oils and products, beverages, newsprint and paper, woodpulp, other manufactures and l.c.l. were lighter. Newsprint totalled 295,958 tons against 328,383 tons shipped in April, 1948, while other manufactures and miscellaneous receded from 722,723 to 643,843 tons. L.C.L. merchandise was down 37,026 tons at 262,957 for the month.

Cumulative totals to the end of April show 45,553,206 tons carried by Canadian railways compared with 48,511,228 tons in the same period last year, a decrease of 2,758,022 tons or 5.7 p.c.

On a provincial basis during April gains in domestic loadings over April, 1948, were registered in the Prairie Provinces and Prince Edward Island, with Manitoba reporting 436,011 tons against 592,574 tons one year earlier, Saskatchewan 796,617 compared with 551,397 tons and Alberta 1,172,548 tons against 1,058,527. Declines were considerable in Nova Scotia, New Brunswick and Quebec, while British Columbia tonnage eased from 782,447 to 710,580 tons of domestic production.
