MONTHLY TRAFFIC REPORT OF RAILWAYS OF CANADA

MAY, 1949

Canadian railways transported 11,851,358 tons of revenue freight during May compared with 11,557,127 tons in April and 12,259,205 tons in May of last year. The decline from 1948 was 407,847 tons or 3.3 p.c., and occurred throughout four of the five groups, agricultural being the exception. Loadings at Canadian stations, however, were advanced from 8,773,901 to 8,915,019 tons, or by 1.6 p.c., while receipts from foreign connections dropped from 3,465,504 to 2,916,359 tons with both imports and intransit freight showing reduced movements. Analysed by provinces, loadings were heavier than in May, 1948, in Prince Edward Island, up from 42,103 to 43,505 tons, Manitoba at 516,100 tons against 451,615 tons, Saskatchewan increasing from 456,173 to 644,783 tons or 48 p.c., and Alberta climbing from 828,912 to 1,007,641 tons or by 21.6 p.c. British Columbia loadings eased slightly in the comparison with the same month of last year while Quebec dropped from 1,692,251 to 1,494,161 tons and Ontario from 3,522,472 to 3,257,760 tons. Nova Scotia declined nearly 56,000 tons while New Brunswick volume was down 30,651 tons to 304,082.

Loadings of agricultural products at Canadian stations added to 1,881,825 tons during May compared with 1,359,408 tons one year earlier. Good gains were registered in wheat, up from 672,623 to 991,102 tons, corn 35,894 tons against 7,684, oats 200,658 compared with 108,048 tons, barley at 194,651 against 99,236 tons, and in flaxseed and other grains, potatoes and fresh vegetables. Declines were shown in flour, other mill products, hay and straw, apples and fruit.

Animals and animal products were down from 127,400 to 102,959 tons, as cattle and calves, horses, hogs, dressed meats, butter and eggs, hides and leather and other non-edible animal products moved in lighter volume. Cheese shipments increased. Loadings of mine products were fairly well maintained at 3,063,497 against 3,074,912 tons in May, 1948, but coal dropped from 968,935 to 835,686 as bituminous output declined. Iron, copper and other ores and concentrates gained while crude petroleum jumped from 49,719 to 133,776 tons. Forest products continued to move in smaller volume, pulpwood totalled only 362,321 tons compared with 602,189 tons and other classes declined. Lumber and plywood totalled 460,649 tons against 487,976 tons in May, 1948.

Among the manufactures and miscellaneous group, gasoline loadings increased from 279,915 to 324,022 tons and foreign receipts by rail declined. Other advances were shown in pig iron, sugar, rails and fastenings, cement up from 155,829 to 162,511 tons, sewer pipe, agricultural implements, autos, fertilizers, newsprint, and canned goods. Declines were noted in petroleum products, iron and steel, furniture, beverages, paperboard, woodpulp down 57,726 tons to 128,689 tons, other manufactures off from 752,230 to 698,963 tons, and in l.c.i., which dropped 52,286 tons from May last year to 251,866 tons.

Cumulative totals indicate that Canadian lines transported 57,384,564 tons to the end of May this year compared with 60,550,433 last year, a decline of 3,165,869 tons or 5.2 p.c. Of the decrease, receipts from foreign connections were responsible for 2,796,572 tons, leaving a decline of only 369,297 in loadings at stations in Canada during the first five months of the current year as compared with the same period of 1948.
