MONTHLY TRAFFIC REPORT OF RAILWAYS OF CANADA
JUNE, 1949

Revenue freight carried on Canadian railways in June aggregated 11,292,914 tons, down 1,270,304 tons or 10.2 p.c. from the same month last year and 1,676,579 tons below June, 1947. Volume in each of the five main groups was below June one year ago in both domestic loadings and receipts from foreign connections. Freight loaded at stations in Canada totalled 8,383,092 tons compared with 9,093,160 tons in June, 1948, while receipts from connections declined from 3,470,058 to 2,909,822 tons with recessions shown in imports for consumption and in intransit traffic.

Provincial loadings were lighter in June of this year in all provinces except in British Columbia where mine, forest and manufactures and miscellaneous products registered gains over the corresponding month of 1948 when flood conditions had restricted movement in some areas of the province. Volume in Prince Edward Island and Alberta showed minor decline from the preceding June but Nova Scotian loadings were down 14.3 p.c. or 133,935 tons, principally in mine products, New Brunswick off 22.5 p.c., due to forest products declining, Quebec down 19.5 p.c. or 365,012 tons mostly in forest products, Ontario 6.3 p.c. with mine and forest products down, while Manitoba and Saskatchewan, despite gains in some groups, had recessions of 6.3 p.c. and 17.7 p.c. respectively.

Total loadings at Canadian points of agricultural products were 1,520,466 tons during June compared with 1,346,241 tons one year earlier, down 2 p.c. Increases were shown in corn, barley, rye, flaxseed, other grains, other fruit, potatoes, vegetables and other agricultural products, while wheat eased from 685,721 to 643,877 tons, oats were little changed at 145,898 tons against 145,973, but flour dropped from 140,624 to 119,397 tons. Other mill products, hay and straw, cotton and apples moved in smaller volume this June.

Animal products suffered considerable decline due in part to reduced exports. Horses were off from 6,849 to 2,561 tons, hogs from 16,192 to 14,455 tons, while dressed meats, eggs, wool, hides and non-edible products were reduced. Live stock increased from 41,588 to 46,420 tons and butter and cheese loadings gained. The total for the group at 109,725 tons was off 14,891 tons from June, 1948.

Smaller coal output was mainly responsible for a decrease of 137,806 tons in domestic loadings of mine products. Bituminous coal declined from 726,106 to 666,519 tons and sub-bituminous from 180,627 to 107,863 tons. Increases were registered over June, 1948, in anthracite, iron ore, copper ore up from 145,651 to 172,168 tons, base bullion, sand and gravel, crude petroleum up nearly 78 p.c. at 122,422 tons compared with 68,860 tons one year earlier, and in asphalt.

Forest products dropped sharply from 1,579,652 to 1,226,952 tons with pulpwood declining 358,300 tons to 474,968 tons. Logs and lumber showed small increases over the preceding June, as well as other forest products. Cordwood receded from 45,378 to 31,609 tons.

In the manufactures and miscellaneous group, the total at 2,599,567 tons for the month under review was down 178,896 tons. Gasoline, petroleum oils, pig iron, rails, iron and steel, castings, beverages, newsprint, woodpulp, other manufactures and l.c.l. merchandiss loadings were lighter. Newsprint grossed 246,167 tons against 278,293 tons in June, 1948, while woodpulp dropped from 173,741 to 110,259 tons in a similar comparison. L.C.L. was off 26,848 tons to 250,491 tons for the month. Increases were recorded in sugar, cement up from 149,901 to 169,270 tons, building products, agricultural implements at 38,763 tons against 32,892 tons and in automobiles, trucks and parts, up from 37,963 to 45,238 tons. Fertilizers, other paper and fish also improved.

During the first six months of the year a total of 68,677,478 tons of revenue freight were transported by Canadian railways, a decline of 4,436,173 tons or 6.1 p.c. from the peacetime record established in the same period of 1948 but nearly double the tonnage hauled in the first half of 1939 - 34,758,506 tons - a remarkable growth in a decade.
