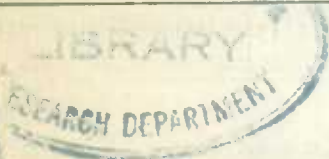

MONTHLY TRAFFIC REPORT OF RAILWAYS OF CANADA

JULY, 1949

Canadian railways transported 10,876,025 tons of revenue freight during July, a decline of 1,715,550 tons or 15.6 p.c. from the same month of 1948, and nearly 416,900 tons below June of this year. Volume was the lightest for any July since 1941. Loadings at stations in Canada declined from a revised 9,268,526 tons in July of last year to 8,158,987 tons, while receipts from foreign connections aggregated 2,717,038 tons, down 605,991 tons from the revised receipts for the corresponding period of 1948.

Six commodities - coal, pulpwood, wheat, lumber, other mine products and miscellaneous manufactures were mainly responsible for reduced traffic this July, although the majority of other items also moved in smaller volume over Canadian lines. Coal and coke traffic declined some 527,500 tons as the effect of slow-downs and strikes in American pits became apparent. Coal tonnage carried by vessels on the Great Lakes - St. Lawrence Waterway was similarly affected. Pulpwood dropped from 885,753 to 475,968 tons or by 411,785 tons from the previous July and the movement of wheat was down 114,789 tons to 581,765 for the month. Lumber shipments were reduced 125,259 tons to 565,585 tons, while other manufactures and miscellaneous were down 227,084 tons at 945,941 for the month as compared with one year ago.

Intransit traffic totalled 1,178,615 tons as against 1,442,158 tons in July, 1948, and imports declined from a revised 1,878,889 to 1,558,421 tons, due largely to smaller deliveries of coal.

Loadings at Canadian stations registered recession in each of the five main groups. Agricultural products at 1,209,681 tons were 146,680 tons lighter as wheat loadings eased from 655,205 to 555,755 tons. Barley, flour, other mill products, potatoes and cotton also declined, while corn, rye, flaxseed, fresh fruits and vegetables advanced. Animal products were down 7,378 tons to 113,118 as the shipments of horses, sheep, hogs, meats, eggs, butter, wool, hides and leather and other animal products were reduced. Cattle and calves improved from 44,118 to 50,219 tons, while other packing house products at 8,127 tons were up 5,755 tons over July, 1948, and cheese weighed 4,985 tons as against 4,121 tons.

Among domestic mine products, loadings of bituminous coal declined from 821,725 to 700,971 tons despite the sharp reduction in imports, which might have been expected to stimulate domestic output somewhat. Sand and gravel eased over 58,000 tons to 416,309 tons and stone was down nearly 48,600 tons. Other mine products receded from 466,858 tons in July last year to 356,047 tons. However, good gains were shown in iron ores which climbed from 114,057 to 348,647 tons and in copper ores, other ores and concentrates, crude petroleum, up from 81,255 to 137,928 tons and in asphalt. All items in the forest products group were lower this July with domestic pulpwood off 402,100 tons and lumber down 119,425 tons. Manufactured items displayed a mixed trend with gasoline and petroleum oils, cement, agricultural implements, autos and trucks increasing, and sizeable declines shown in pig iron, rails, iron and steel, building products, beverages, fertilizers, paper, woodpulp off from 170,820 to 96,014 tons, in miscellaneous manufactures down from 701,705 to 581,690 tons, and in L.C.L. freight at 221,410 tons compared with 266,447 tons in the preceding July.

Each province registered a reduction from the same month of last year in volume of loadings with percentage declines ranging from 5.5 p.c. for Ontario to 40.5 p.c. for Prince Edward Island. Quebec tonnage was down 19.7 p.c., British Columbia 8.5 p.c., New Brunswick 35.8 p.c., Nova Scotia 14.6 p.c., and the Prairies - Manitoba 15.6 p.c., Saskatchewan 21.9 p.c. lighter and Alberta 6.2 p.c.

Cumulative totals for all revenue freight carried to the end of July at 79,555,501 tons shows a drop of 6,149,705 tons or 7.2 p.c. from the same period of 1948 and remain some 5,879,200 tons below 1947. However, compared with the 41,035,000 tons transported in the first seven months of 1939, the current year's volume presents some cause for satisfaction as reflecting the remarkable economic progress of the past decade. Canadian railways carried an average of 1,710 pounds of freight per capita of population each month this year compared with 1,040 pounds per month per capita in the same period of 1939.
