MONTHLY TRAFFIC REPORT OF RAILWAYS OF CANADA

AUGUST, 1949

Revenue freight carried by Canadian railways during August totalled 12,290,855 tons, up 1,414,852 tons over July, but 655,164 tons or 4.9 p.c. less than the revised total of 12,924,019 tons in August, 1948, and 49,522 tons below the same month of 1947. Loadings at stations in Canada advanced to 9,513,187 tons compared with 9,211,567 one year earlier, an improvement of 101,570 tons, but receipts from foreign connections sagged from a revised 3,712,452 to 2,977,718 tons, a decline of 734,734 tons, attributable mainly to greatly reduced coal and crude petroleum imports. All freight transported registered an increase only in the agricultural products group, which rose 475,194 tons or 26.5 over August, 1948, to 2,268,617 tons, with wheat, oats and barley featured. Animals and animal products eased 24,559 tons to 196,750, with most items lower, and mine products dropped from a revised 5,284,163 to 4,817,982 tons, due principally to the coal strikes in the United States. Forest products continued to decline from 1948 levels with 580,800 tons less carried at 1,510,963 tons, as pulpwood and lumber loadings were considerably reduced. The manufactures and miscellaneous group showed a drop of 6 p.c. or 256,618 tons from the previous August to 3,696,543 tons for the month under review, with pig iron, iron and steel, wood pulp, other manufactures and miscellaneous and l.c.l. merchandise down.

Foreign receipts for Canadian delivery receded from 2,140,189 tons in August, 1948, to 1,649,645 tons, and reflect lower imports of coal, while intranait traffic mostly across Southern Ontario dropped from 1,572,265 to 1,528,075 tons in line with smaller loadings in the United States.

Canadian loadings, however, registered improvement in agricultural and mine products over August, 1948. With wheat shipments increasing from 713,100 to 974,270 tons, oats from 91,528 to 212,424 tons and barley up from 94,469 to 188,995 tons, the total for Canadian agricultural products rose some 500,000 tons over the previous August to 1,841,195 tons. Mine products due to a wide gain in iron ore from 156,595 to 404,573 tons advanced from 3,582,546 to 3,493,912 tons. Crude petroleum loadings more than doubled at 154,954 tons against 71,195 tons in August, 1948. Animal products loaded at Canadian stations eased from 143,686 to 127,451 tons with live stock and meats lower. Forest products dropped from 1,583,803 to 1,216,843 tons with pulpwood and lumber greatly reduced. The manufactures and miscellaneous group showed mixed tendencies; gasoline, cement, automobiles, furniture, and newsprint advanced, but petroleum oils, pig iron, iron and steel, agricultural implements, beverages, fertilizers, woodpulp, fish, other manufactures and miscellaneous and L.C.L. were down. The total for the group at 2,655,756 tons was 128,676 tons under August last year.

Cumulative totals of all freight carried by railroads in Canada to the end of August at 91,844,356 tons show a decrease of 6,782,867 tons or 6.1 p.c. from the first nine months of 1948 and 5,929,050 tons under the 1947 cumulative. Comparable data for railways in the United States indicate a decline of over 12 p.c. from 1948 levels, due in part to labour unrest with coal, forest products, l.c.l. and miscellaneous down sharply.

Loadings by provinces during August showed good gains in the Prairies due to better crops. Manitoba shipments were up from 589,591 to 894,541 tons, Saskatchewan with 829,669 tons against 562,709 in the previous August and Alberta advancing 58,759 tons to 943,907. Ontario and British Columbia volume was well maintained but the Maritimes and Quebec were down considerably. Prince Edward Island dropped from 12,663 to 5,296 tons, with declines in sand and gravel and vegetables. Nova Scotia reported 705,762 tons against 759,558, while forest products caused a retreat of 94,030 tons to 268,285 tons in New Brunswick. Quebec volume at 1,651,290 was off 172,812 tons from August, 1948, with forest products down over 128,000 tons and manufactures and miscellaneous 49,000 tons lighter.
