MONTHLY TRAFFIC REPORT OF RAILWAYS OF CANADA
SEPTEMBER, 1949

The tonnage of domestic and foreign revenue freight transported by Canadian railways during September totalled 12,870,451 tons, a seasonal increase of 579,576 tons over August but 10.1 p.c. or 1,451,566 tons below the record September of 1948 and 795,425 tons under September of 1947. The total carried in the corresponding month of 1939 was 10,179,523 tons, indicating a considerable advance in the decade from the first wartime month, while September of 1938 had registered only 7,799,284 tons carried.

Loadings at Canadian stations during September at 10,077,290 tons dropped 709,658 tons from the same period of 1948 despite an increase in wheat which rose from 1,418,046 to 1,544,622 tons. Declines were heavy in domestic shipments of live stock, other ores and concentrates, sand and gravel, all forest products, and in the majority of manufactured commodities. Receipts from foreign connections continued to drop sharply from 1948 levels with 1,571,685 tons destined to Canadian points compared to 2,042,648 tons in the preceding September and 1,221,458 tons intransit against 1,492,401 tons one year earlier, a decline in foreign receipts of some 741,908 tons or 21 p.c., and reflecting the interim recession and strikes besetting the American economy as well as September's currency devaluation which tended to reduce imports from the U.S. dollar area.

Of all freight carried during the month under review, an increase was shown only in agricultural products which advanced 87,418 tons over September, 1948, to 3,094,892 tons. Animals and animal products were down from 266,554 to 219,108 tons. Mine products shrank 753,169 tons to 4,777,352 tons for the month as the total coal moved declined over 516,000 tons, principally in receipts from American sources for domestic use; a soft coal strike was called about September 20th which lasted 52 days. Sand and gravel was off some 122,400 tons but crude petroleum at 162,852 tons advanced 28,872 tons over the previous September. Here domestic loadings rose from 71,446 to 157,427 tons while imports dropped from 82,066 to 5,375 tons to save considerable hard currency. Forest products registered recessions all along the line, the total off nearly 445,000 tons to 1,089,411 tons for the month. Pulpwood sagged from 584,950 to 362,251 tons and lumber was off 180,335 tons to 558,856 tons. The manufactures and miscellaneous group, while easing 293,407 tons to 3,689,688 tons, displayed more activity in the gasoline and petroleum, cement, brick, automobile, furniture and fertilizer industries. Cement shipments, mainly to build the great hydro developments, increased from 151,463 to 207,879 tons. The movement of iron and steel was considerably affected by labor troubles in the United States. Pig iron was down 40,900 tons and iron and steel 29,848 tons, mostly in intransit shipments. Agricultural implements moved in reduced volume, down from 57,540 to 44,873 tons. Newsprint paper and other paper shipments were considerably lighter, while woodpulp dropped 29 p.c. and canned goods 30 p.c. Other manufactures and L.C.L. were down 147,322 and 50,448 tons, respectively.

The grand total of freight carried in the first nine months of 1949 was 104,714,787 tons, a decrease of 8,234,453 tons or 7.2 p.c. from the same period of 1948 and compares with 111,439,262 tons in the first three quarters of 1947. Only agricultural products, mainly wheat, registered a gain over 1948 while reductions in forest products were rather severe, particularly in pulpwood and lumber.

Of the terminations during September, 9,642,807 tons were unloaded at stations in Canada, while 3,429,651 tons or 28.2 p.c. were delivered to foreign connections.

Loading by provinces during the month show gains over the preceding September in Prince Edward Island up from 8,109 to 11,957 tons with potatoes and vegetables rising sharply, and in each of the Prairie Provinces. Saskatchewan loadings advanced from 1,148,941 to 1,244,191 tons with wheat featured. The so-called industrial provinces (Ontario, Quebec, British Columbia, Nova Scotia) and New Brunswick registered considerable declines. The last named decreased 21.9 p.c., due principally to forest products, while Quebec loadings were off 11.5 p.c. from the preceding September, Ontario 10.7 p.c., Nova Scotia 9.7 p.c., and British Columbia 11.2 p.c.
