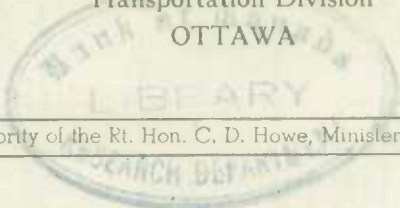

MONTHLY TRAFFIC REPORT OF RAILWAYS OF CANADA

JANUARY, 1950

The volume of revenue freight carried by Canadian railways during January was down rather sharply at 9,662,264 tons compared with 11,113,742 tons in January of 1949 and 11,599,866 tons in 1948. Weather conditions, particularly in the western division, restricted loadings, while the coal strike in the United States lessened intranet and import traffic. The decrease from January last was thus 15 p.c. or 1,451,478 tons. The current total was the smallest for any January since 1942, but remains considerably above the 5,467,082 tons carried in the same month of 1939. Newfoundland loadings are included for the first time and were 24,085 tons for the month; thus the decrease for the other nine provinces was actually 1,475,561 tons from the preceding January.

Freight loaded at Canadian stations amounted to 7,170,389 tons compared with 8,202,591 tons one year earlier while receipts from foreign connections were 419,276 tons lighter at 2,491,875 tons for the month under review. Imports were down 240,665 tons with coal and coke, sugar, iron and steel, fertilizers and other manufactures reduced. Intranet traffic was lower in agricultural products, coal, coke, castings, implements, other manufactures and L.C.L., the total off 178,611 tons.

Agricultural products carried during January at 1,599,958 tons were 395,862 tons under the corresponding period of 1949 as wheat declined 221,479 tons to 611,256 tons and barley, rye, flaxseed, other grains, fruit and most other items were down sharply. Only potatoes and fresh vegetables registered worthwhile gains. Animals and animal products were 9,595 tons lighter at 199,775 tons, although dressed, cured and salted meats rose 10,024 tons. Live stock shipments advanced slightly. Mine products reflected the effects of labor trouble in the United States and were down 8.5 p.c. or 333,227 tons below the traffic carried in the previous January. Anthracite coal was 75,272 tons lighter and bituminous plus sub-bituminous shrank 154,607 tons. However, Canadian lignite shipments improved from 155,509 to 219,698 tons. Other ores and concentrates dropped 109,588 tons to 452,619 tons for the month. Forest products moved in considerably reduced volume due to lack of snow for woods operations in the East and a surfeit of the same in the Pacific region. Pulpwood decreased 219,007 tons or nearly a third from January, 1949, lumber dropped 26,092 tons and logs 71,975 tons or 54 p.c. The Manufactures and Miscellaneous group showed nine commodities with heavier movement and sixteen declines. Petroleum oils due to encouraging domestic production rose 40,172 tons to 287,805 and rails and fastenings, cement, automobiles, newsprint and other paper resisted the downward trend. Iron and steel decreased 55,541 tons to 251,219, implements were off 10,821 tons to 47,409 as farm purchases and exports eased, beverages dropped 19,390 tons to 39,466, and fertilizers 26,291 tons to 118,057 tons for the month. Other manufactures and miscellaneous group was sharply reduced in domestic and foreign receipts, the total off 212,566 tons or 19.2 p.c. at 892,476 tons. L.C.L. freight amounted to 221,377 tons, some 63,860 tons under the preceding January.

Terminations during the month show 71.6 p.c. of freight carried unloaded in Canada, while 28.4 p.c. was delivered to foreign connections.

Provincially, loadings were lighter this January in all provinces except Saskatchewan which climbed from 615,507 to 651,941 tons due to increased lignite coal shipments. Nova Scotia declined from 853,340 to 795,032 tons with iron and steel products down. New Brunswick forest products were greatly reduced and the provincial total slipped from 534,632 to 291,257 tons. Declines in Quebec in forest products were offset by advances in mine products and the provincial total eased 32,107 tons to 1,201,005 tons. Ontario loadings were generally lighter and the total at 2,545,740 tons was 13.4 p.c. under the preceding January. Manitoba volume was nearly maintained but Alberta shrank 401,444 tons or 34.4 p.c. to 766,301 tons for January, with the movement of agricultural products greatly reduced. British Columbia beset by discouraging weather loaded only 564,534 tons during the month compared with 722,524 tons one year earlier.

An analysis of Newfoundland freight traffic for the first month reveals that 24,085 tons were loaded and 21,259 tons unloaded in the new province. There were 1,919 tons of agricultural products unloaded and only 192 tons loaded, similarly, animal products were imported to the amount of 875 tons. Some 497 tons of flour were entered by rail, 109 tons of live stock, some 566 tons of various dressed meats and poultry as well as 12 tons of cheese. The deliveries from the island were mainly newsprint, woodpulp and fish.
