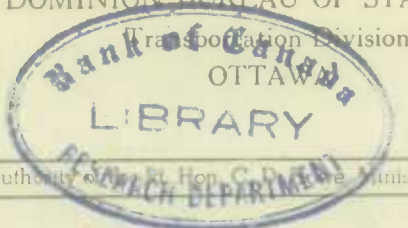

MONTHLY TRAFFIC REPORT OF RAILWAYS OF CANADA

FEBRUARY, 1950

Revenue freight transported by Canadian lines during February totalled 9,806,650 tons, down 1,184,007 tons or 10.4 p.c. from the corresponding month last year but up from the 9,662,264 tons reported for January of the current year. February volume compares with 11,288,511 tons in 1948 and 10,172,281 tons in 1947. The effects of western snow and weather conditions and coal strikes in the United States tended to restrain volume. Newfoundland freight totalled 55,551 tons and was not included in February of 1949. February loadings at stations in Canada amounted to 7,587,488 tons as against 8,185,958 tons one year earlier, a drop of 598,470 tons or 7.3 p.c., while receipts as imports for consumption slipped from 1,404,481 to 1,024,555 tons and intranait freight declined 205,409 tons to 1,194,809 tons. The decrease in freight shipments to Canadian points from foreign connections was mainly in bituminous coal, iron and steel, and manufactures.

Domestic loadings were lighter in the Agricultural Products group, which declined from 1,448,250 tons in February of 1949 to 1,165,964 tons with wheat down from 756,780 to 455,211 tons. Barley, rye and flaxseed also dropped considerably but flour, other mill products, apples, potatoes and other agricultural products registered gains. Heavier cattle and hog shipments moved the Animals and Animal Products group up from 94,249 to 101,857 tons. Mine products loaded improved from 2,647,004 to 2,828,656 tons, up 6.9 p.c., as domestic bituminous and lignite coal shipments increased in the face of sharply reduced imports from the United States. Bituminous rose over 91,000 tons to 865,580 for the month. Domestic iron ore climbed from a mere 82 tons in February last year to 29,420 tons, all on the Algoma Central. Copper, stone, slate and salt also were up, while crude petroleum jumped from 100,016 to 165,652 tons with Alberta production booming.

Forest products total loadings continued to show large decreases from 1949 volume, the total for the group at 1,175,670 tons, down nearly 18 p.c. or 455,084 tons from February of last year. Pulpwood slipped from 1,055,577 to 672,194 tons and logs from 154,474 to 79,552 tons. However, lumber shipments were better maintained at 567,647 tons against 579,595 tons one year earlier, and plywood rose from 8,259 to 11,165 tons. Other forest products improved 5,746 tons to 14,196 tons for the month under review.

The Manufactures and Miscellaneous group showed minor recession from February of last year with the total at 2,515,541 tons as compared to 2,565,721. Gains in gasoline, petroleum oils, lime and plaster, sewer pipe, autos, furniture, woodpulp, fish and canned goods contrasted with losses in pig iron, rails, iron and steel, cement, brick, implements, beverages, fertilizers, paperboard, miscellaneous manufactures and L.C.L. Newsprint loaded totalled 316,515 tons against 519,478 tons one year earlier. Autos and trucks climbed from 51,846 to 44,708 tons as demand remained steady. The decline in L.C.L. shipments was 28,228 tons to 188,781, while miscellaneous dropped 41,556 tons to 517,097 tons.

By provinces, loadings were heavier this February in Prince Edward Island which increased from 24,545 to 28,778 tons due to larger potato shipments. Nova Scotia, with coal and other mine products advancing, had 754,894 tons against 699,656 tons one year earlier. New Brunswick loadings, due to reduction in pulpwood, declined 29,250 tons to 517,149 tons. Quebec volume was 85,908 tons or 6.5 p.c. lighter at 1,244,280 tons, with forest products off sharply from 585,710 to 257,280 tons. Ontario showed 2,626,497 tons loaded during the month, a decline of 455,464 tons. Agricultural products, principally wheat, mine products and forest products, were off considerably.

With reduced grain shipments, the Prairies as a region registered recession. Manitoba loadings dropped from 555,019 to 518,882 tons, Saskatchewan 110,026 tons to 576,182 tons but Alberta, with live stock, coal and oil shipments up, increased from 939,919 to 1,077,567 tons. British Columbia, harassed by snow blockages, reported 608,928 tons loaded during February against 667,087 tons one year earlier. Forest and mine products declined but agricultural products advanced as apples rose from 15,568 to 35,676 tons.
