MONTHLY TRAFFIC REPORT OF RAILWAYS OF CANADA

APRIL, 1950

Revenue freight carried by the principal Canadian railways during April weighed 10,831,850 tons as against a revised total of 11,376,098 tons in the same period last year and 12,180,375 tons in April of 1948. The reduction from 1949 of 544,248 tons or 4.8 p.c. was principally in the volume of agricultural products and manufactures. Newfoundland data is now included in both Aprils. Flood conditions in southern Manitoba towards the end of the month seriously disrupted normal movements. Foreign receipts were heavier particularly in coal, pig iron and iron and steel with intratransit freight up from 1,284,857 to 1,379,711 tons as business activity spurted in the United States after the mid-month.

Loadings at Canadian stations were 7,958,354 tons during April, down 683,986 tons or 7.9 p.c. from the revised 8,642,320 tons reported for the previous April, (revised to include Newfoundland). Receipts from foreign connections for stations in Canada totalled 1,493,805 tons compared with 1,448,921 tons one year earlier as bituminous coal rose from 346,267 to 549,141 tons.

Canadian loadings were lighter this April in all main groups except mine products. The agricultural commodities dropped from a revised 2,080,196 to 1,521,732 tons, with wheat reduced 473,473 tons to 791,085 tons for the month. Barley, rye and flaxseed were down sharply while flour, other mill products, apples and potatoes moved in greater volume.

Animals and animal products slipped 4,335 tons from April, 1949 volume to 104,598 for the month with cattle and calves off 4,339 tons to 37,689 tons and dressed meats, eggs, butter, wool, hides and leather lighter. However, hogs rose from 18,897 to 20,356 tons and other packing-house products, cheese, and non-edible animal products increased.

Good gains were recorded in several mine products with the total for the group up 94,196 tons at 2,766,377 tons for April. Bituminous coal from domestic mines aggregated 803,385 tons during the month against 681,501 tons one year earlier and sub-bituminous and lignite also increased. Iron ore, copper ore, asphalt, crude petroleum at 146,693 tons compared with 139,976 tons, and other mine products improved.

Among forest products, pulpwood dropped from 386,978 to 257,790 tons but lumber etc. rose 76,592 tons to 484,618 and the group total was reduced from 945,496 to 909,501 tons.

The manufactures and miscellaneous group showed seventeen items lower than in the preceding April and eight heavier: petroleum oils, rails, newsprint up from 300,871 to 329,469 tons, and woodpulp at 162,387 against 125,325 tons featured. Gasoline was off 31,094 tons to 228,814, pig iron from 86,977 to 50,191 tons, iron and steel from 137,474 to 99,808 tons, and cement 20,113 tons lighter at 173,132 tons for April of this year. Automobiles and parts were down but foreign receipts rose. Fertilizers declined from 254,305 to 197,915 tons, miscellaneous manufactures from 645,353 to 604,421 tons and L.C.L. shipments were 37,061 tons lighter at 238,385 tons.

By provinces, loadings in the current April were increased in Newfoundland at 63,211 tons compared with 39,065 tons one year earlier, New Brunswick volume improved slightly while British Columbia with mineral and forest output advancing, showed 831,180 tons loaded during April as against 710,380 tons in the same period of 1949. Prince Edward Island loadings were off 1,035 tons to 48,645 tons, Nova Scotia eased from 787,449 to 766,844 tons, and Quebec from 1,371,342 to 1,342,479 tons. However, the decline in Ontario and the Prairie Provinces was of more serious proportions. Ontario had 2,706,891 tons against 3,011,551 tons one year earlier with sizeable decreases in agricultural and mine products. The recession in Manitoba was mainly in grain and the provincial total was down 58,143 tons to 377,868. Saskatchewan wheat shipments were considerably lighter this April and the provincial total at 586,483 tons was off 210,154 tons. Alberta, despite increased mineral output, was reduced from 1,172,548 to 962,774 tons in view of the lighter grain movement.

The cumulative total for the first four months reveals that 42,078,086 tons of freight were carried by Canadian railways, some 3,514,091 tons or 7.7 p.c. under that transported in the similar period of 1949 and 12.9 p.c. below the 48,311,228 tons in 1948, despite the addition of Newfoundland loadings.
