MONTHLY TRAFFIC REPORT OF RAILWAYS OF CANADA

MAY, 1950

Revenue freight moved by Canadian railways during May totalled 12,811,721 tons, a good gain of 714,178 tons or 6 p.c. over the tonnage carried in May last year when the total revised to include Newfoundland was 11,896,543 tons. This advance was shown despite disastrous floods in southern Manitoba which brought embargoes and serious interruptions to freight loadings and the normal movement through Winnipeg. The volume of freight loaded during the month at Canadian stations aggregated 9,603,529 tons against 8,982,204 tons one year earlier, up nearly 7 p.c. Foreign receipts for domestic use eased from 1,702,851 to 1,586,645 tons but intranait traffic, spurred by gains in grain, autos and manufactures, increased from 1,218,488 tons in May, 1949, to 1,420,547 tons.

Canadian loadings were heavier this May in the Animal and Animal Products group up from 105,042 to 114,895 tons, in Mine Products advancing from 3,074,888 to 3,714,384 tons and in Manufactures and Miscellaneous which increased 191,607 tons to 3,075,517 tons. Agricultural Products declined from 1,882,142 tons to 1,670,927 tons while loadings of Forest Products eased only 10,414 tons to 1,028,008. By commodities, volume was reduced in wheat off from 991,102 to 975,579 tons and in corn, barley, rye flaxseed and flour. Potatoes registered an increase with 83,613 tons loaded against 52,970 tons in May, 1949. Cattle and calves, hogs, and other (non-edible) animal products moved in larger quantities. Among the minerals, bituminous coal loaded rose from 701,451 to 832,359 tons. Sub-bituminous and coke also increased. Iron ore more than doubled at 561,712 tons compared with 176,033 tons in the preceding May. Base bullion, sand and gravel and stone rose appreciably. Crude petroleum totalled 159,531 tons against 153,776 tons one year earlier. Salt and other mine products were much heavier. The main decline in forest products was in pulpwood at 288,683 tons against 393,664 tons in May 1949, but lumber jumped from 454,875 to 542,154 tons in response to eager demand from U. S. sources.

Among manufactured items, petroleum oils, cement up from 163,040 to 253,351 tons, brick, lime and plaster, automobiles and trucks up from 42,484 to 47,942 tons, fertilizers, newsprint, woodpulp, canned goods and other manufactures were featured. Gasoline was down slightly. Pig iron, rails, iron and steel, implements, beverages, fish and L.C.L. were also reduced in volume from that of the previous May.

Provincial loadings show advances in Prince Edward Island from 43,505 to 58,458 tons, with potatoes up sharply, and in Nova Scotia at 1,007,982 tons against 897,277 tons one year earlier, due mainly to increased coal shipments. New Brunswick total rose 19,565 tons to 323,647 reflecting increases in woodpulp, newsprint, gasoline and sugar, as well as in potatoes and hay and straw. The Quebec aggregate at 1,644,818 tons compares with 1,494,161 tons in May of 1949 and registered gains in all groups except forest products. Ontario stations reported 3,376,495 tons against 3,257,760 tons with increases in mine products offsetting declines in other groups. Manitoba loadings reduced by flood conditions dropped 59,403 tons under the previous May to 456,697 tons. The decline in agricultural products was sharp from 206,994 to 94,152 tons, but mine products advanced from 170,939 to 280,007 tons. Saskatchewan volume improved from 644,783 to 724,241 tons with all groups except forest products heavier. Alberta despite a drop of 75,567 tons in agricultural products registered a gain of 50,183 tons over May, 1949, to 1,057,824 tons as mineral output boomed. The British Columbia total rose appreciably 145,235 tons to 894,602 for the month with all groups joining in the advance. Lumber rose from 158,841 to 191,371 tons and bituminous coal from 74,954 to 104,954 tons.

Cumulative figures show 54,690,807 tons of freight carried by Canadian lines in the first five months of the current year, some 2,800,000 tons under the volume transported in the similar period last year. Preliminary totals for June and July indicate that this decrease will be considerably reduced in a seven-month comparison.
