MONTHLY TRAFFIC REPORT OF RAILWAYS OF CANADA

SEPTEMBER, 1950

Revenue freight carried by Canadian railways during September amounted to 13,375,891 tons, an increase of 411,154 tons or 3.2 p.c. over the same month of 1949 and 3,101,867 tons better than August of 1950 when the nine-day strike sharply reduced volume. The total for September of 1949 revised to include Newfoundland was 12,964,737 tons while September 1948 volume had reached a record 14,321,997 tons.

Loadings at Canadian stations during the month under review grossed 9,950,170 tons, receipts from foreign connections for domestic customers were 2,095,982 tons and intrasit freight 1,329,739 tons. Compared with the previous September, Canadian loadings were down 221,484 tons while imports rose sharply 524,557 tons due to heavier coal receipts, and intrasit freight increased by 108,281 tons reflecting improved industrial activity in the United States. September, 1949 volume had been affected by U. S. strikes and currency devaluation by Canada.

By provinces, loadings during September registered gains in Newfoundland, up from 94,556 to 131,578 tons, and in Nova Scotia, New Brunswick 38,679 tons heavier at 320,966 tons, Quebec up from 1,544,810 to 1,641,133 tons, Ontario at 3,451,895 tons against 3,071,530 tons one year earlier, in Alberta and in British Columbia where the provincial total climbed to 935,923 tons compared with 800,379 tons in the preceding September. The totals for Prince Edward Island, Manitoba and Saskatchewan were cut sharply. Manitoba dropped from 1,192,068 to 589,453 tons due to such smaller grain shipments caused by later harvest, while Saskatchewan slipped from 1,244,191 to 848,198 tons, with grain moving much more slowly. The eastern provinces and British Columbia were bolstered by an encouraging recovery in the forestry group as well as advances in mining and manufacturing. The huge declines in western grain shipments, however, offset various increases elsewhere in other commodities.

Total freight carried by the reporting lines showed agricultural products at 1,964,418 tons for the month or a loss of 1,130,782 tons from the previous September. Wheat shipments were more than halved at 780,383 tons against 1,570,169 tons one year earlier, while oats, barley, other grain, flour, hay and straw, fruits, potatoes and vegetables were sharply lower. Only corn, cotton, rye and other mill products registered gains. A later harvest, lower grades and hesitant overseas demand combined to discourage the grain movement during the month. The decline in animals and animal products was 33,910 tons to 185,403 with live stock, meat, dairy products and hides reduced. Wool, horses and non-edible products advanced. Mine products, however, posted a good gain, up 930,456 tons over September, 1949 to 5,724,042 tons. Anthracite coal improved 194,538 tons to 565,922 and bituminous 161,496 to 1,356,654 tons. Iron ores jumped to 452,459 tons or 179,508 tons above one year earlier. Coke, other ores, bullion and building materials gained. Crude petroleum showed 199,034 tons or 36,202 above September, 1949. Other mine products rose 127,004 tons to 855,770 tons. The entire mining group was activated by defence preparations as well as heavier domestic demand. The forestry group sparked by an increase of 245,397 tons in lumber and timber rose 315,658 tons over the previous September to 1,458,686 tons with logs and pulpwood also much heavier. The manufactures and miscellaneous group improved 329,732 tons to 4,043,542 tons for the month. Petroleum oils, pig iron, iron and steel, automobiles, other paper, wood pulp, canned goods, other manufactures and miscellaneous and L.C.L. featured the advance. The last two named rose 142,165 tons and 21,535 respectively, to post gains of 13.8 p.c. and 7 p.c.

The cumulative total of all freight carried for the first nine months was 103,224,387 tons or 2,095,702 tons under the similar period of 1949 (revised to include Newfoundland), a decline of about 2 p.c. However, based on weekly carloadings, volume in the last quarter of the year recovered most of the loss suffered in the first three quarters and the total for 1950 should not be much altered from 1949.
