MONTHLY TRAFFIC REPORT OF RAILWAYS OF CANADA

JANUARY, 1951

Canadian railways opened the traffic year with the heaviest January on record, carrying a total of 12,270,222 tons of revenue freight. This was an increase of 2,607,958 tons or 27 p.c. over January last year when domestic loadings were restricted by weather conditions and receipts from U. S. lines reduced by the coal strike there. In January, 1941, only 8,088,127 tons were transported, indicating an advance of over 51 p.c. in the decade. January of 1949 showed 11,113,742 tons carried.

For the month under review, 9,558,065 tons were loaded at Canadian points against 7,170,589 tons during January last year, 1,615,414 tons were received from foreign connections for delivery in Canada compared with 1,221,645 tons and 1,518,743 tons of freight moved intransit over Canadian lines as against 1,270,250 tons in the preceding January. Thus domestic loadings rose over 50 p.c., imports 52 p.c., and intransit volume 5.8 p.c.

All provinces shared in the general increases over January, 1950 traffic. The Atlantic Provinces reported a gain of 251,202 tons to a total of 1,469,525 tons. Quebec rose from 1,620,693 to 2,092,719 tons and Ontario lines at 5,542,561 carried 909,066 tons more than in the corresponding month of last year. The Prairie region reported an advance of 705,606 tons to 2,470,414 tons while in British Columbia loadings and foreign receipts amounted to 895,003 tons, up from 602,945 tons one year earlier. The movement in all commodity groups, except animals and animal products, was decidedly greater. Agricultural products increased over 741,000 tons to 2,541,215 tons, mine products rose from 5,586,427 to 4,209,991 tons and forest items were 596,291 tons heavier at 1,565,009 tons. The Manufactures and Miscellaneous items totalled 5,967,452 tons or 658,088 tons above January, 1950. The decline in animal products to 188,557 was limited to 11,218 tons.

Turning to a comparison of loadings at Canadian stations, all provinces reported decided improvement over January, 1950 volume. Newfoundland showed large gains in mine and forest output while Prince Edward Island's total rose from 30,179 to 45,546 tons on the strength of heavier shipments of oats, potatoes, livestock and pulpwood. Nova Scotian loadings were greater in salt, other mine products, iron and steel and most manufactured items. Apple shipments sagged from 5,254 to 1,222 tons. In New Brunswick, sharp advances in forestry production and manufactures offset declines in agriculture, and the provincial total moved up from 291,257 to 404,702 tons. In Quebec all groups except animal posted good increases with forest items totalling 355,223 tons against 184,510 tons one year earlier and manufactures up nearly 139,000 tons to 610,594 tons. The Ontario total at 5,208,215 tons loaded represents a gain of 28 p.c. or 662,475 tons as agricultural products, mine, forest and manufactures improved considerably. With heavier grain loadings and increases in stone, pulpwood, cement and paper, the Manitoba aggregate was up over 180,000 tons to 480,420 tons. Similarly, Saskatchewan loaded 120,000 more tons of wheat as well as an increased volume of various grains, lignite, pulpwood, gasoline and petroleum. The provincial total rose from 651,941 to 865,862 tons. Loadings of agricultural products in Alberta jumped from 158,489 to 419,511 tons with the grain movement accelerated. Pulpwood and lumber, petroleum products, cement, fertilizers and other manufactures were much heavier. Coal shipments advanced but the drop in crude petroleum from 104,733 to 52,429 tons due to the pipeline, forced a reduction to the total for mine products. The provincial loadings during the month amounted to 1,062,950 tons against 786,501 tons for all commodities in January, 1950.

In the coastal province, loadings totalled 854,126 tons against 564,554 tons one year earlier with all five commodity groups higher. Large gains were indicated in apples, other animal products, coal, ores, bullion, products of the forest, and most manufactured items.

The encouraging gains recorded in January over the same month of 1950 appear to have been continued to the end of April with weekly carloadings at record levels.

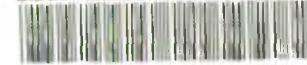
