MONTHLY TRAFFIC REPORT OF RAILWAYS OF CANADA

NOVEMBER, 1951

While down seasonally from the maximum established in October, the volume of revenue freight handled by Canadian lines during November approached the record for the month with 14,557,806 tons for a gain of 740,472 tons or 5.4 p.c. over the corresponding period of 1950. This total compares with 12,855,169 tons in November of 1949 and the peak of 14,565,078 tons reported in the eleventh month of 1948.

Cumulative traffic to the end of November totalled 148,049,965 tons, up 16,072,204 tons or 12.2 p.c. over the first eleven months of 1950 and is a new record for the period. This was accomplished despite a loss of some 1,089,000 tons of crude petroleum to pipelines, as well as the diversion of considerable L.C.L. freight to highway carriers. Canadian stations loaded 11,104,986 tons during the month under review against 10,432,292 tons one year earlier, up 6.45 p.c. Receipts from connections included 2,002,070 tons for domestic use compared with 1,859,772 tons indicating increased imports, while intransit freight dropped to 1,430,750 tons from 1,505,270 in the previous November due mainly to reductions in U. S. corn, automobiles and miscellaneous manufactures moving across Canadian territory.

In total freight carried, advances were shown in agricultural products up from 2,925,449 to 3,575,260 tons, in forest products 157,990 tons heavier at 1,422,374 tons and in manufactures and miscellaneous with 4,116,755 tons against 4,015,710 tons one year earlier. Petroleum oils, iron and steel, cement, newsprint and woodpulp were much stronger. Livestock declines carried the animals and animal products group down to 214,374 tons from 247,451 while lighter ore deliveries eased the mine products total to 5,211,045 tons, or some 154,717 tons under the preceding November's traffic.

The domestic loadings were appreciably higher in agricultural products which advanced 671,917 tons to 3,159,679 tons. Wheat increased nearly 533,000 tons to 1,745,863 tons and corn, oats, barley, flaxseed, potatoes and vegetables posted good gains over the previous November. Heavier loadings of horses, sheep and hogs failed to offset a decrease of 26,493 tons in cattle and calves at 52,799 tons and the Animals and products group was down from 161,786 to 156,598 tons. Bituminous and lignite coals were shipped in greater volume but iron and other ores, sand and gravel, crude petroleum, and other mine products were off sharply and the group total was 205,228 tons lighter at 3,625,954 tons. Forestry items posted wide increases in logs and pulpwood but lumber dropped from 614,747 to 589,821 tons. The total for the group rose from 1,161,350 to 1,295,148 tons with pulpwood up 131,236 tons to 474,777 tons.

The manufactures group registered betterment with 2,869,907 tons loaded for an increase of 96,575 tons. Petroleum oils and products, sugar, rails, iron and steel, agricultural implements, automobiles and parts, beverages, newsprint, woodpulp, canned goods and other manufactures and miscellaneous were featured in the advance. Gasoline, cement, building products and L.C.L. freight showed losses compared with the preceding November, the latter item dropping from 227,198 to 207,250 tons, or by nearly 9 p.c.

All provinces except Nova Scotia had heavier loadings as compared with November of 1950. The Newfoundland total moved up from 62,905 to 68,525 tons with a doubling in mine products due to sharp increases in sand and gravel and stone, probably related to the highway development under way. Prince Edward Island, with a good market for pulpwood, loaded 31,460 tons in November against 28,237 tons one year earlier. The drop of 43,865 tons to 915,302 tons in the Nova Scotia total was due to reduced coal and other mine products shipments. New Brunswick registered an advance of 55,028 to 375,056 with agricultural and forestry items much better. The Quebec aggregate was up slightly at 1,654,099 tons from 1,652,760 tons in November of 1950. Four of the five groups were lower but greater manufacturing output pushed the provincial total higher. Petroleum products, cement, iron and steel, beverages, newsprint and woodpulp posted fair gains.

For Ontario, loadings rose 224,475 tons or 7 p.c. to total 3,570,045 tons. Agricultural deliveries were up from 554,246 to 660,564 tons due mainly to wheat, corn, oats and barley which were much heavier. Manufactures also improved but animal, mine and forest products totals were off. The increase in grain loadings in Manitoba served to offset the decline in mine products and the provincial total at 948,918 tons gained 45,538 tons over the previous November. Saskatchewan, similarly on the strength of much better grain loadings, advanced from 1,149,947 to 1,275,563 tons with wheat up from 581,429 to 702,421 tons. Mine products, principally lignite, also improved. Total loadings for Alberta weighed 1,262,379 tons compared with 1,125,438 tons one year earlier. Agricultural products moved up from 411,091 to 528,559 tons and forest products led by pulpwood and lumber showed betterment.

Traffic in British Columbia reflected the resumption of forestry operations which had been curtailed by the summer drought and the provincial total increased to 1,005,845 tons from 904,858 tons one year previously. Logs rose from 67,465 to 126,440 tons while lumber loadings increased 85,649 tons to 256,209 tons. Agricultural and mine products loadings were off slightly on the coast, while animal products gained 1,795 to 9,649 tons. The manufactures group slipped from 187,829 to 169,591 tons due mainly to lower deliveries of fertilisers and miscellaneous manufactures.
