MONTHLY TRAFFIC REPORT OF RAILWAYS OF CANADA

DECEMBER, 1951

Canadian railways moved a total of 12,202,663 tons of revenue freight during the month of December, an increase of 149,801 tons or 1.24 p.c. over the same month of 1950 and 10.5 p.c. above the 11,039,414 tons carried in December of 1949. Of the overall volume handled, some 9,386,592 tons were loaded at Canadian stations compared with 9,031,565 tons one year earlier, a betterment of 355,027 tons or 4 p.c. Import freight from foreign connections was off 38,749 tons to 1,535,425 tons while intransit revenue shipments were down from 1,447,123 to 1,280,646 tons due to lighter movements of corn, coal, automobiles, and miscellaneous manufactures across Canada between American points. Bituminous coal imports by rail were considerably lower this December with the total receding from 549,247 to 422,549 tons. Iron and steel receipts from abroad, however, were much heavier.

Canadian loadings registered gains in Agricultural Products at 2,801,068 tons for the month, an increase of 526,364 tons or 26.6 p.c. from the previous December. Wheat was much more active with an advance of 419,449 tons to 1,387,263 tons. Oats rose from 187,413 to 225,621 tons and barley was over 97,000 tons heavier at 271,331. Corn, rye and flaxseed also joined in the betterment as well as cotton and potatoes. Other grains, flour, paper mill products, apples and fresh fruits were moved in lighter volume. The Animal and Animal Products group continued to lower levels with only 93,081 tons against 126,182 tons for the previous December and 175,706 tons in the same period of 1949. Livestock loadings were pared from 49,386 tons a year earlier to 20,619 tons. Sheep and lambs and dressed meats also declined but hogs were better at 20,181 against 18,587 tons. The Mine Products classification dropped 230,480 tons to 2,908,159 due to lower coal deliveries, sub-bituminous decreasing from 355,382 to 286,845 tons, and to other ores and concentrates which were off 111,676 tons to 359,568 tons. Gains were indicated in iron ores, sand and gravel, and stone. Crude petroleum moving by rail from Canadian sources dropped 39,273 tons to 31,763 tons for the month due to the pipelines. Forest Products displayed steady improvement in primary production, totalling 1,258,090 tons for an increase of 13 p.c. or 143,923 tons over December of 1950. Logs, posts, poles etc. moved up from 98,472 to 150,485 tons while pulpwood was featured with an advance of 196,380 tons to 560,484 tons. Lumber loadings were down from 528,909 to 440,660 tons, reflecting the decline in building permits across Canada as well as reduced sawn lumber production. The Manufactures and Miscellaneous total posted a minor decline in December at 2,626,194 tons, off 51,679 tons for the corresponding month of 1950. Commodities loaded in better volume included petroleum oil and products up over 39,000 tons to 332,512 tons, iron and steel manufactures at 139,389 against 110,263 tons, castings, beverages, other papers, fish, and canned goods. Shipments of agricultural implements, etc., automobiles, gasoline, fertilizers, cement and miscellaneous manufactures were fairly well maintained. Declines were noteworthy in pig iron, building products, furniture, newspaper off from 325,563 to 303,777 tons, woodpulp, and L.C.L. freight which dropped to 163,242 tons from 191,692 tons in the previous December.

Provincial loading totals registered gains in Newfoundland up from 39,293 tons in December of 1950 to 49,760 tons with mine and forest and manufactured products better. Prince Edward Island reported 37,053 tons against 22,691 with greatly improved pulpwood deliveries. Potatoe shipments also gained. The Nova Scotia total was slightly higher at 773,295 tons up only 1,005 tons. Forestry items offset declines in mine output. New Brunswick showed a sizeable advance of 71,513 tons to 330,306 up over 27 p.c. with forest products much heavier. The Quebec total declined 59,572 tons to 1,429,370 tons in December as compared with the same period of 1950. All five commodity groups showed recessions. Ontario, with agricultural deliveries much heavier, had a total of 2,998,326 tons of revenue freight loaded during the month for a gain of 132,567 tons or 4.6 p.c. Manitoba loadings were down from 541,302 tons during December of 1950 to 509,401 tons in the month under review. Forest products and manufactures improved but the other groups were lighter. Heavier grain shipments moved the Saskatchewan total up to 1,253,817 tons from 1,045,629 tons one year earlier. Forest products also showed betterment but animal, mine and manufactured items were down.

The Alberta aggregate was up nearly 60,000 tons from 1,133,912 to 1,193,797 tons. Agricultural products rose sharply to 517,748 tons, an increase of 175,268 tons over December, 1950. Mine products dropped nearly 107,000 to 484,854 tons due to lighter coal receipts.

In British Columbia the total for the month at 811,467 indicated a decrease of 61,487 tons from one year earlier. Agricultural items, mine products, and manufactures slipped to lower levels while animal and forest products improved.

The preliminary cumulative of revenue freight carried during 1951 at 160,252,628 tons indicates a gain of 16,222,005 tons or 12.6 p.c. over 1950. This is an all-time record. A detailed analysis of 1951 data will be presented in the "Summary of Monthly Traffic Reports, 1951" which will be issued later in bulletin form.
