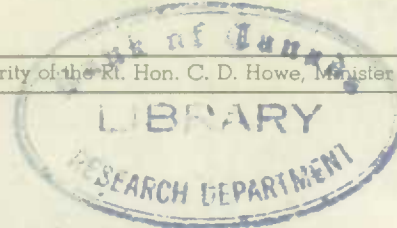

MONTHLY TRAFFIC REPORT OF RAILWAYS OF CANADA

MARCH, 1951

Canadian railways carried an impressive total of 12,552,650 tons of revenue freight during March for a gain of 6.8 p.c. or 775,328 tons over the same month of 1950. This compares with 12,111,680 tons in March of 1949, the peacetime record of 13,242,676 tons in 1948 and the wartime peak of 13,525,007 tons in March of 1944. Weather conditions in the Prairies during the month hindered movement somewhat. Loadings at Canadian stations amounted to 9,144,285 tons against 8,829,501 tons one year earlier, an increase of 3.6 p.c. Receipts from foreign connections supplied the balance of 3,408,365 tons with 1,592,665 tons for domestic delivery and 1,815,700 tons in transit. These latter totals compare with 1,485,550 tons and 1,462,271 tons respectively in March of 1950, indicating considerable improvement in imports and rail activity in the United States where revenue freight carried during March increased 14.7 p.c. in volume over the corresponding month of 1950.

Provincial loadings showed gains over last year in all provinces except Newfoundland, Saskatchewan and Alberta where the diversion of crude oil to the pipelines greatly reduced the volume of mineral products handled by rail. Unloadings at stations were heavier in March this year in all eastern provinces while the Prairies and British Columbia were down considerably.

Among all freight carried during the month, Agricultural Products were 157,775 tons lighter than in the previous March and totalled 1,851,337 tons with sizeable reductions in wheat, oats, rye, apples, hay and straw and potatoes. Animals and Animal Products dropped from 188,194 to 165,965 tons as livestock, sheep, hogs, dressed meats and hides were lower. Mine Products with coal and crude petroleum sharply reduced, were off 351,177 tons or 8 p.c. to 3,806,657 tons. Forest Products moved were appreciably higher, amounting to 2,094,660 tons or 650,719 above March 1950 volume. Pulpwood featured with a gain of 554,004 tons to 1,135,188, while lumber, etc., increased 100,035 tons to 703,179. The Manufactures and Miscellaneous group posted a worthwhile advance of 635,790 tons, moving up from 3,998,241 to 4,634,031 tons as the heavy industries required greater amounts of pig iron, iron and steel and castings. The automotive output was moved in larger volume, up from 196,512 to 267,128 tons. Building products, beverages, newsprint and other paper, woodpulp, canned goods and miscellaneous freight posted good gains over the preceding March. L.C.L. shipments registered a minor gain.

In the first quarter of the current year a near record total of 36,028,402 tons of revenue freight were carried. This represents an increase of 4,782,166 tons or 15.3 p.c. over the similar period last year and compares with 34,216,079 tons in 1949 and 36,150,855 tons to the end of March, 1948.

Similarly, loadings at Canadian stations increased 3,175,169 tons from 23,587,578 tons in the first three months of 1950 to 26,762,547 tons in 1951, while receipts from foreign connections rose from 7,658,858 to 9,265,855 tons in a like comparison. Imports for domestic use were up 992,041 tons and in transit freight increased 614,956 tons.
