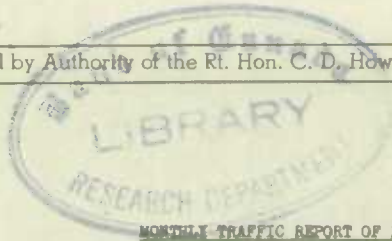

MONTHLY TRAFFIC REPORT OF RAILWAYS OF CANADA

APRIL, 1951

The tonnage of revenue freight transported by Canadian railroads during April advanced to a new record of 12,614,522 tons for a gain of 1,782,672 tons or 16.5 p.c. over the volume moved in the same month last year. The present total compares with the wartime peak for the month of 12,573,170 tons in 1943, and only 8,579,517 tons in April of 1941. The advance in the decade was thus over 4,035,000 tons or 47 p.c. Operating conditions during the current April were more favourable than last year when serious flood conditions were experienced, particularly in Manitoba. Also, Easter was earlier this year with its holiday effect on March volume and on April in 1950.

Canadian stations reported 9,413,428 tons loaded during April against 7,958,534 tons one year earlier, up 18.5 p.c. Receipts from foreign connections supplied 1,559,716 tons for domestic delivery compared with 1,495,805 tons, while intransit freight increased from 1,379,711 tons in April last year to 1,641,381 tons.

Of the ten provinces, only Prince Edward Island and Alberta showed reduced loadings this April. Spectacular gains were reported for Quebec and Manitoba with the elder province loading 1,805,123 tons against 1,542,479 tons one year earlier and Manitoba having 594,114 tons compared with 377,868 tons. Nova Scotia was up from 766,844 to 887,955 tons and New Brunswick volume improved 108,612 tons to 580,571. Ontario had 3,182,981 tons for an advance of 476,090 tons or 17 p.c. Saskatchewan showed 698,597 tons, up from 586,483 tons one year previously and the coast province loaded 895,286 tons or 64,106 tons more. Newfoundland increased 2,487 tons to 65,698 while the declines in Prince Edward Island and Alberta were 2,407 tons and 105,912 tons respectively. The drop in crude oil and bituminous coal shipments was rather severe in the foothills province. Crude oil, due to pipeline diversion, dropped from 141,678 to 37,577 tons.

In total freight carried during April, Agricultural Products amounted to 2,253,870 tons or 305,577 tons above the corresponding period of 1950. Wheat, oats, barley, rye, flour and the other agricultural products group posted good gains while hay and straw and potatoes were down sharply. The Animals and Animal Products items totalled 17,368 tons heavier at 184,172 tons despite lower livestock and hog shipments. Mine Products posted a minor increase of 40,875 tons to 3,991,898 tons as reductions in coal and crude petroleum tended to offset gains in coke, iron ore, miscellaneous ores, bullion and building products. The forestry group continued strongly upward with a total of 1,639,459 tons carried during the month for an impressive advance of 644,562 tons over April, 1950 volume. Pulpwood increased 443,275 tons as newsprint mills reported record demand. Lumber rose 137,662 tons to 680,645 tons for the month. Improvement was widespread among the Manufactures and Miscellaneous group with the total up 774,490 tons to 4,545,123 tons. The heavy industries were very active. Iron and steel moved up 85,137 tons to 527,543 tons and automotive freight increased 65,365 tons to 253,004 tons. Woodpulp was 44,623 tons heavier at 225,276 tons while papers were all advanced. Other manufactures and miscellaneous rose 329,755 tons to 1,341,620 tons and L.C.L. merchandise was up 11.5 p.c., or 52,178 tons to 517,684 for the month under review.

During the first four months a total of 48,642,924 tons of revenue freight was carried. This represents an increase of 6,564,858 tons or 15.6 p.c. over the same period last year and is the best peacetime showing on record. Preliminary reports for May through July indicate that the high volume of freight traffic has been well maintained.
