MONTHLY TRAFFIC REPORT OF RAILWAYS OF CANADA  
AUGUST, 1951

Canadian railways reported revenue freight at a new high for the month in August at 14,354,922 tons. This compares with the previous record of 13,873,204 established in 1943, 10,274,024 tons in August last year, which had been depreciated by the nation-wide strike, and 12,411,503 tons in the similar period of 1949. The advance over August, 1950, was 4,080,898 tons or nearly 40 p.c., which indicated considerably heavier daily average loadings this August. In July of the current year 13,977,167 tons were carried by all lines.

Canadian stations showed 10,912,615 tons loaded against only 7,418,211 tons in the previous August and 9,313,137 tons in 1949. Receipts from foreign connections supplied 2,012,702 tons for domestic use compared with 1,423,846 tons a year ago while intransit freight totalled 1,429,605 tons against 1,431,967 in August of 1950.

Cumulative totals for the first eight months of the present year indicate that Canadian railways have handled a record 104,782,835 tons of revenue freight for a gain of 14,934,339 tons or 16.6 p.c. over the similar period last year. This compares with 92,355,352 in 1949 and the previous high of 103,188,889 tons to the end of August, 1944, in which period war supplies were moving in heavy volume to the U. K. and Europe.

Due in part to the strike last August, all commodity groups registered large increases with the exception of animals and animal products which rose only 2,319 tons to 166,108 tons. Agricultural products carried amounted to 2,865,011 tons, up 1,472,811 tons over August, 1950, under pressure of a heavy crop this year. Mine products totalled 5,218,558 tons or 1,078,109 tons more with only bullion, slate and crude petroleum lower. Forest products jumped 573,969 tons to 1,901,802 despite reduced lumber shipments. Most manufactured items advanced and the total at 4,203,443 was up 953,690 tons. Sugar, rails and automobiles were the sole commodities to show significant declines from August, 1950.

Canadian loadings by provinces naturally registered large increases over the abbreviated loading period enforced during August of last year. Newfoundland volume rose from 78,646 to 126,114 tons with a large gain in forest products. Prince Edward Island on the strength of greatly augmented pulpwood deliveries advanced from 5,906 to 16,939 tons. Nova Scotia accounted for nearly 693,000 tons against 549,000 while New Brunswick improved from 228,475 to 430,770 tons as forestry items were much better. The Quebec aggregate loadings were 2,053,967 tons, up 583,250 tons or 40 p.c. Ontario volume at 3,944,478 tons gained 1,256,873 tons, up 46.3 p.c. The prairie provinces registered spectacular gains with Manitoba loadings increasing 223,135 tons to 584,752 tons, Saskatchewan more than doubling from 515,673 to 1,192,427 tons on the strength of greatly increased grain shipments and Alberta advancing from 784,252 tons in August, 1950 to 997,002 tons, despite the drop in crude petroleum diverted to the pipelines. British Columbia though bothered by drought loaded 893,174 tons or 136,774 tons above the previous August.

It should be noted that while the general strike prevailed nine days, the five-day work week in force since June 1st this year reduces the apparent difference in loading days between the two Augusts. Consequently some worthwhile increases were recorded this year on a daily average basis.

Commodities loaded at Canadian points registering outstanding advances over August last year included wheat up from 570,428 to 1,531,566 tons, corn up to 11,118 tons from only 46, oats more than tripled at 305,789 tons and barley some 206,500 tons heavier at 283,085 tons. Flour and other mill products gained while other fresh fruits rose from 2,997 to 14,116 tons. Domestic bituminous coal totalled 597,663 against 527,353 and sub-bituminous rose 34,672 tons to 142,925. Copper ores increased over 50,000 tons at 184,522 tons against 133,925 tons loaded in August one year earlier. Other ores were up 154,456 to 471,785 tons. Sand and gravel improved 119,000 to 470,285 tons and other mine products nearly 57,000 tons to 464,016. Forestry items, except lumber, advanced widely. Logs, etc. rose to 132,558 from 88,142 tons in the previous August while pulpwood soared to 962,564 tons from 436,365 tons. Gasoline and petroleum oils both posted good gains. Pig iron at 98,824 tons compared with 41,820 tons while iron and steel increased 57,598 tons to 128,599. Cement gained 50,082 tons to 153,945 and other building products were much heavier. Agricultural implements and automobiles and parts from Canadian factories posted increases over August, 1950 volume, but the intransit movement of autos between American stations was much reduced. Beverages also advanced from 36,016 to 57,706 tons as the railways strove to regain this traffic. Fertilizers were up 52,675 tons at 124,152. Newsprint totalled 300,869 tons in August against 249,707 one year earlier. Woodpulp was 54,245 tons heavier at 216,989. Other manufactures and miscellaneous amounted to 729,651 tons for a gain of nearly 222,000 tons or 43.7 p.c. L.C.L. totalled 217,212 tons at Canadian stations compared with 166,796 tons in August of 1950.

The main decreases were confined to rye, fresh apples, livestock off from 42,061 to 36,564 tons, dressed meats, eggs, butter, hides and leather and non-edible animal products. Base bullion slipped from 99,219 to 84,325 tons while crude petroleum dropped 78,280 tons to 84,896. Lumber eased from 640,708 to 625,604 tons and sugar decreased by 9,831 tons to 28,372.

Terminations during the current August show 71.4 p.c. as unloaded at stations in Canada and the balance of 4,095,085 tons or 28.6 p.c. going to foreign delivery.
