MONTHLY TRAFFIC REPORT OF RAILWAYS OF CANADA

SEPTEMBER, 1951

Revenue freight carried by Canadian railways during September totalled 15,151,975 tons, a decrease of 1.5 p.c. or 205,181 tons from the revised total of 15,557,154 tons handled in corresponding period of 1950, but above the 12,964,757 tons reported for September of 1949. The record for the month was established in 1948 at 14,521,997 tons. September of 1950 had benefitted to some extent by the backlog of freight which had accumulated here and in the United States during the late August nine-day national strike.

However, Canadian stations loaded 10,016,090 tons during the month compared with 9,950,170 tons one year earlier but receipts from connections dropped from 5,586,984 to 5,115,885 tons with the decline concentrated in entries for domestic consumption, the major recessions occurring in hard and soft coal. Intransit freight was up slightly this September at 1,295,958 tons.

A scamping of provincial loadings shows increases in half of the ten provinces. Newfoundland volume at 150,820 tons was only 558 tons under September of 1950. Prince Edward Island traffic jumped from 7,939 to 19,142 tons with greatly augmented pulpwood shipments. New Brunswick at 376,866 tons was up 55,900 tons. Quebec province advanced from 1,641,133 to 1,719,692 as forestry output accelerated. Manitoba, with a heavier grain movement, totalled 705,171 tons against 589,455 tons one year earlier, and Saskatchewan at 1,151,828 tons posted a grain-inspired gain of 505,650 tons loaded. The Nova Scotia total was off some 70,000 tons to 820,111 tons as other mine products and coal shipments were reduced. Ontario mines and manufactures were less productive of rail freight and the provincial total, despite a good gain in agricultural products, eased from 5,451,895 to 5,512,472 tons. Alberta, due to reduced crude oil and mineral shipments, declined from 1,152,975 to 975,982 tons or by 14 p.c. For British Columbia, loadings amounted to 906,006 tons in September, a drop of 129,917 tons with all five main commodity groups lower. Drought cut forestry operations and bullion and other ores were lighter.

Agricultural products loaded in Canada totalled 2,228,022 tons during September for an excellent gain of 625,662 tons over the same month of 1950. Wheat was up from 755,110 to 1,276,492 tons. Oats increased nearly 100,000 tons to 215,755. Corn and barley also improved, but rye and flaxseed were lower. Flour loaded at 125,260 tons was up 14,137 tons while other mill products dropped to 139,564 from 185,282 tons. Apple shipments were lighter but fresh fruits gained 27 p.c. to 25,553 tons. Animals and animal products continued to decline at 101,208 tons against 127,447 tons one year earlier. Livestock, horses, and sheep were considerably lower while hogs were steady. Dairy products, wool and hides and leather were much lower. Reduced shipments of coal, iron ore, other ores and concentrates, other mine products, bullion and crude petroleum offset the gain in sand and gravel and the mine products loadings were down from 3,998,448 tons in September, 1950 to 3,582,009 tons. The combined total for coals and coke was 1,144,009 tons against 1,295,623 tons one year earlier. Forestry items were generally lower but a wide increase in pulpwood loadings from 439,859 to 719,605 tons produced an advance of 55,700 tons in the group total at 1,410,151 tons. Lumber dropped from 719,201 to 508,661 tons.

The manufactures and miscellaneous group showed a decrease of 170,764 tons or 6 p.c. to 2,694,700 tons in the recent September. The main recessions were in L.C.L. freight off nearly 82,000 tons to 200,879 tons and in other manufactures down 46,000 to 678,675 tons. Gasoline, petroleum oils and products, sugar, pig iron, castings, building products, furniture, fish, and canned goods were much lighter. Advances were reported in iron and steel up from 115,970 to 159,573 tons, agricultural implements, automobiles, beverages and fertilizers. Newspaper paper was increased from 240,558 to 252,955 tons and woodpulp gained 24,371 tons to 195,159.

The cumulative total of all revenue freight carried during the first three quarters of 1951 was a record 117,914,808 tons, an increase of 14,729,158 tons or 14.3 p.c. over the similar period of 1950 and 12,594,719 tons above the first nine months of 1949. The current total exceeds the wartime peak of 1944 when 116,822,561 tons were carried to the end of September.
